A. CSIP (2024-25) Review

Proficiency Goals

- To surpass the state proficient and distinguished average in Reading and Mathematics by 2024-25.
- To surpass the state proficient and distinguished average in Science, Social Studies, and Writing by 2024-25.
- Ensure that teachers are designing and delivering quality instruction and practices.

Achievement Gap

- Decrease the students with novice in Combined Writing scores from 22% in 2023-2024 to 10% in 2024-2025.
- Decrease the students with novice Reading scores from 32% in 2023-2024 to 25% in 2024-2025.
- Decrease the students with novice Math scores from 32% in 2023-2024 to 25% in 2024-2025.

English Learner Progress

- All students in the EL group at HCHS will move at least 2.5 levels as measured by ACCESS by the Spring of 2027.

Quality of School Climate and Safety

- To improve the consistency of behavior expectations and implementation.
- To improve the overall respect between students on a daily basis.

Postsecondary Readiness

- Increase students being Postsecondary Ready from 88.3% in 2023-2024 to 94% in 2024-2025.
- Increase Special Education students being Postsecondary from 91% in 2023-2024 to 94% in 2024-2025.

Graduation Rate

- Increase the graduation rate from 94.3% in 2023-2024 to 95% in 2024-2025.
