**Parade Regulations:**

1. Parade will begin at 3:30 pm Friday, Oct 20 from the El Dorado Municipal Auditorium.
2. Drivers must be 21 years of age or older.
3. Horse entries must show proof of Coggins test.
4. ALL entries MUST be decorated (not just a sign). Signs or banners will not be permitted unless they relate to the overall theme for homecoming.
5. Entries must be in assigned spot at auditorium and ready to be judged by 2:45.
6. Other regulations include:
  - Walking groups MUST be accompanied by an adult.
  - Candy or other objects CANNOT be thrown from an entry at any time.
  - This will prompt automatic disqualification!!!!**
  - Inappropriate/explicit music will not be permitted and will lead to automatic disqualification.
  - All participants riding a float must be seated at all times while float is in motion.
  - At no time should an entry stop to dance, cheer, or perform!!!!**
7. Winners will be chosen based on the following attributes:
  - Application of theme
  - Originality
  - Creativity
  - Expression of Wildcat Spirit
