

Creating a Setup Guide for the HubSpot App Marketplace

Overview

A publicly available setup guide (also referred to as "setup documentation" and "supporting documentation") is required to be listed or certified in the HubSpot App Marketplace. Setup guides help prospects and customers learn how to install, configure, use, and disconnect and/or uninstall your app/integration.

Use this template to create a setup guide which meets both listing and certification requirements.

For reference, the setup guide requirements are copied below:

Listing (see full requirements):

A link to a publicly available (no sign-in, no paywall) Setup Documentation specific to your HubSpot integration.

- Your Setup Guide cannot simply be your homepage or a general knowledge base.
- Instead, it must contain the steps to install and configure the integration.
- For an example, check out the OrgChartHub setup guide.

Certification (see full requirements):

Supporting documentation for your app must:

- Exist on a live, publicly accessible URL (i.e. no paywalls or login required) and adhere to current accessibility, privacy, and GDPR standards.
- Be up-to-date and consistent with the current version of your app.



- Clearly describe:
 - What your app does.
 - How to install your app and connect a HubSpot account with screenshots of each step, including the scope approval screen.
 - o How to configure your app once it is installed.
 - How to use your app, including both manual and automated interactions.
 - How to disconnect HubSpot from your app.
 - How to uninstall your app from a HubSpot account.
 - How disconnecting and uninstalling might affect users' HubSpot accounts and data.
- Include images. Any images containing screenshots of the HubSpot UI should be up-to-date and consistent with our design system.
 - Videos are also recommended, but not required. Videos should be updated regularly and reflect the current version of your app.

Template/Example





Configure:

Use:

Disconnect:

Note: If you disconnect your HubSpot account from {{ App Name }}, {{ Platform Name }} lead and account data will no longer sync to HubSpot contacts and companies (and vice versa). Existing data will remain on your HubSpot records.

FAQs

Can I use a format that differs from this template?

Yes. The template above is a guideline of best practices. If you follow it, your setup guide will have a very strong probability of meeting HubSpot's requirements for both listing and certification. However, every setup guide/setup documentation/supporting documentation <u>must</u> include instructions to install and configure the app. Instructions to use and disconnect/uninstall the app are recommended for listing but only required for certification.



Can instructions to install, configure, use, disconnect, and uninstall my app/integration be published on separate pages?

Yes, but all pages or articles must still be publicly available and hyperlinked to the main "Setup documentation URL" included on your App Marketplace listing.
