# Accommodation Suggestions for Summer Intensive 2025

This document aims to provide a guide for transportation and accommodation in Paris.

To enhance your stay during the course, we have prepared a document with accommodation suggestions in the area. This link provides information on lodging options near the event venue, offering various amenities and prices to suit your needs.

## About Conservatoire de Pantin

The Conservatoire à Rayonnement Départemental (CRD) de Pantin, managed by Est Ensemble, moved into a new building on avenue du Général Leclerc in October 2022. It adjoins the recently renovated Alice Milliat swimming pool.

The conservatory's year-round vocation is to contribute to everyone's artistic learning, offering teaching and numerous forms of amateur and professional artistic practice (music, dance, plastic arts and theater).

It has 2 dance studios and a 250-seat auditorium. The renovation project was lead by [Novembre Architecture](#) around reflections on people's uses, between urban creation and heritage, and population diversity.

Also worth noting: the conservatory is right next to the [Centre National de la Danse](#) and the Canal de l'Ourcq.

With the latter app, you can either load them onto a <b>Navigo Easy pass (available at stations for €2)</b> or store them directly on your iPhone or Android phone.</p> <p>We recommend the Citymapper app, which gives precise directions (time, price, best exit, etc.) for getting around the city (perhaps more than googlemaps).</p>
Vélib bike-sharing	<p>Bikes can be dropped off at stations near the conservatory:</p> <p>Station n°35004 - Place du Président Salvador Allende =&gt; <a href="#">See the map</a></p>	<p><b>Ticket - V 3€</b> One way trip on an electric or classic bike, for max. 45 minutes.</p> <p><b>3-day pass - 20€</b> 72h with Vélib (electric bikes included)</p>	<p>Check your bike before choosing it, as it sometimes has flat tires or broken seats.</p> <p><a href="#">More information (EN)</a></p>
Cab	49 avenue du Général Leclerc, 93500 Pantin		<p>If you book a cab or car service (e.g. Uber, G7), think about your options and budget.</p> <p>Travel times may be similar to those provided by the public</p>

			transport network, but the cost will likely be much higher than a metro ticket, especially if you're traveling alone.

## How to go to Paris

Category	Access	Comments/tips
Car / Car sharing	<a href="#">49 avenue du Général Leclerc, 93500 Pantin</a>	Car-sharing services like <b>BlaBlaCar</b> are a popular and affordable way to travel to Paris. These platforms connect drivers with passengers, allowing you to share the cost of the trip while enjoying a more relaxed and social journey.
Train	<p>Paris is well connected to neighboring countries by train, making it an easy and convenient travel option.</p> <p>High-speed rail services like the <b>TGV, Eurostar, Thalys, and ICE</b> provide fast connections from cities such as London, Brussels, Amsterdam, and Frankfurt, Geneva, Milan, Barcelona, etc.</p> <p>Additionally, <b>night trains</b> offer a comfortable way to reach Paris from destinations like Vienna, Milan, and Berlin while traveling overnight.</p>	<p>It is recommended to book train tickets to Paris in advance, especially for high-speed trains like the <b>TGV, Eurostar, or Thalys</b>.</p> <p>Booking early can often save you money and ensure you secure a seat, particularly during peak travel times.</p>
Flying	<p>Estimate transportation time with public transportation;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- From Aéroport Paris Roissy CDG: 45 minutes (Regional express train - RER B)</li> <li>- From Aéroport Paris Orly: 55 minutes (Subway - line 14)</li> </ul>	<p>The main airports are <b>Roissy-Charles de Gaulle</b> and <b>Paris-Orly</b>, offering both direct and connecting flights to most cities around the world.</p> <p><b>Paris Beauvais</b> also serves low-cost flights. However, keep in mind that Beauvais is farther from the city, and reaching Paris costs extra.</p>

Worth noting option: Fiap Paris <https://www.fiap.paris/>. Is far (i.e. 30 Rue Cabanis, 75014 Paris = 40 minutes from the conservatoire) but the breakfast is free for each night spent there, and every room has a private bathroom (shower and toilet).
