FAQs / Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

What is the 11th standard online admission process?

This is a web portal facility provided for the centralised admission process to apply online and secure admission for students who wish to take admission in the 11th standard in higher secondary schools affiliated with the State Board in Maharashtra. This is a centralised online system for 11th standard admissions.

Who can apply for 11th standard admission?

Students who have passed 10th standard from any recognized board and wish to take admission in 11th standard in higher secondary schools affiliated with the State Board can apply for this.

Is online registration mandatory?

Yes, offline applications will not be accepted.

How to register online? How to get Login ID and Password?

For this, visit the web portal <https://mahafyjadmissions.in>, click on Student Registration, fill in the required information, and create a password. You will receive the Login ID via SMS. Remember the answer to the security question selected during registration. Take a printout of the security question and password and keep it safe.

Can the admission form be modified after registration?

Yes, you can modify your admission form before the verification of your application by using the Unlock Form option or by contacting the guidance center.

How many higher secondary schools can I give preference to?

A student can register a minimum of 1 and a maximum of 10 higher secondary school preferences.

What documents are required for admission?

10th standard mark sheet, school leaving certificate, and certificates for reservation and special categories as required (as mentioned in Chapter Six of the admission brochure).

I am a student from another board. What should I do?

Students from other boards can also generally apply online. They should fill in their 10th standard marks properly, lock their application, and verify it. If only grades are mentioned in the 10th standard mark sheet, get the grades converted into marks with the help of your school and enter them in the application. You can take the help of your school or guidance center for this. Check the information on the portal to find the nearest center.

To whom is the AT-KT concession applicable and when should such students fill the application for 11th admission?

The government has made the ATKT (Allowed to Keep Terms) concession applicable for 11th admission to State Board students who have failed in 1 or 2 subjects in the 10th standard. This concession is applicable only to Maharashtra State Board students. Such students are given temporary admission in 11th standard of the state board (until they pass all subjects of 10th standard).

The facility to apply for 11th admission for ATKT holding students will be provided after the result of the 10th standard supplementary examination in July (generally after special round 1). Students who have received the ATKT concession will be able to fill out applications for 11th admission. (Even if there is an ATKT in the English subject) it will be mandatory to pass the English subject in the future. If ATKT holding students want to take the Science stream in 11th standard, it is necessary to score 40 percent marks in the Science subject in 10th standard.

If other boards have also applied such a concession (e.g., Compartmental) to their students, it will be applicable for 11th admission in the same board. The ATKT concession of other boards will not be applicable for 11th admission in the State Board. Therefore, students from other boards cannot apply for 11th admission in the State Board unless they clearly pass.

What are the quota types?

In-house quota (10%), Management quota (5%), Minority quota (50%) only in minority schools.

Is an online application required for quota seats as well?

Yes, an online application is required for admission under all types of quotas.

How many rounds are held for admission?

Four regular rounds and thereafter an Open to All Round.

What happens if admission is not confirmed even after getting the first preference school?

If a student gets their first preference higher secondary school and still does not take admission, the concerned student will be disqualified for all subsequent regular rounds.

Can I participate in more than one round?

You can participate in each round until you get admission in the 11th standard. For that, it is necessary to fill and lock parts one and two of your application before each round.

What is the registration fee and how to pay it?

The admission registration process fee is ₹100. It has to be paid online via Net Banking, Debit/Credit Card, UPI, or digital wallet.

Is an offline payment option available?

No, only online payments are accepted.

What if I forget my login details?

Use the Forgot Password option for this or contact the nearest guidance center.

Where will the student get help regarding problems with the admission application?

Can I change the preference order of higher secondary schools?

Yes, before each round, you can update your preference order in Part 2 of your application (Option Form (Part-2)).

Is admission confirmed immediately after the name appears on the admission list?

No, for this, click on Proceed for Admission within the prescribed period, upload the required documents, visit the respective higher secondary school for document verification, pay the prescribed educational fees, and your admission is confirmed only after the concerned school confirms the admission.

What can be done to withdraw from the admission process?

Use the 'Withdrawal of application' option on the portal. This will free up your seat for other students.

Who will verify the original documents?

The higher secondary school allotted to you for admission will verify your original documents by comparing them with the uploaded documents.

Can I change the stream selection in my admission form?

If you have not taken admission, you can change the stream option and the preference order of higher secondary schools in your application before the next round.

What if the information in the application and the original documents are found to be different?

In such cases, the student will be disqualified from the regular rounds and will be given a chance to participate only in the 'Open to All' round.

What if the 10th standard mark sheet is found to be fake or tampered with?

Such a student will be restricted from participating in the admission process for the academic year 2025-26, and legal action will be taken if the mark sheet is found to be fake.

What is the zero round?

This round will be organized before the regular rounds begin. No centralized admissions will take place in this round; only quota-based admissions will be permitted. During this round, activities like preparing a general merit list, resolving doubts, and filling out preparatory applications will be carried out.

Is the online admission process applicable to night schools?

No.

What is the Open to All round?

This will be a special round where admissions will be done purely on merit and the student's preference order. Reservations will not be applicable here. Special rounds will generally be organized after the completion of the four regular rounds. More than one special round can be organized as required. Students who have not yet secured admission, as well as those who were restricted during the regular rounds, can participate in such special rounds.

How will HSVC admissions happen this year?

Offline at the higher secondary school level based on merit.

When should the original documents be submitted?

While filling out part one of the admission form, upload the documents you have, and while taking actual admission in the higher secondary school, submit all original documents as instructed by the school.

What documents are required for sports persons?

There is a reservation for sports students in the admission process. Students with medals and participation certificates at the international level are eligible. Also, only medal-winning students at the national level are eligible. To avail of this reservation, the certificate obtained in the respective competition must be certified by the District Sports Officer and submitted.

What to do if there is no Non-Creamy Layer certificate?

A Non-Creamy Layer certificate (indicating not belonging to the advanced and progressive group) is required to avail of the reservation benefits for VJ, NT, OBC, SBC, SEBC categories. Even if this certificate is not available while filling out the application, it must be obtained by the time of admission. If the parents of students in these categories are not going to get a Non-Creamy Layer certificate, they should choose the option to apply from the open category.

What date should be put on the leaving certificate?

The date the school leaving certificate is issued to a student who has passed the 10th standard will be on that certificate, but the date of leaving the school will be the date the 10th standard result is declared. It is the responsibility of the concerned school to mention the date on the certificate, so students need not worry about it.

What should be the size of the document file in MB?

For the documents to be uploaded while filling out the admission form, the size of each file (document) should be a maximum of up to 1 MB.

What if there is no school leaving certificate for Open School students?

Students who have passed from NIOS Open School are given a passing certificate from that board. Along with that, the school leaving certificate of the standard (e.g., 9th) previously passed should be obtained from the concerned school and both documents must be submitted at the time of admission.

Can a taken admission be cancelled?

Yes. The admission taken can be cancelled at any stage while the admission process is ongoing.

What are the required documents for the wards of freedom fighters?

If the wards of freedom fighters want to avail of the reservation benefit, the ward must be nominated by the freedom fighter, and a certificate from the concerned District Collector regarding being a freedom fighter is required.

What are the required documents for orphan children?

Orphan students must submit a certificate from the Divisional Deputy Commissioner, Women and Child Development Department.

What are the required documents for students coming from abroad?

The leaving certificate and mark sheet with the signature and stamp of the concerned officer of the Indian Embassy in the respective country should be submitted. The certificate and mark sheet should be in English. Foreign resident students will not be able to avail of any social/statutory reservation benefits.

How to register the marks of students from states other than Maharashtra State?

Students of boards other than Maharashtra State can register the marks of the Best 5 subjects in the admission process. However, while selecting the Best 5 subjects, do not include additional or optional subjects.

For example:

If six subjects are mentioned on the mark sheet of CBSE students, the first five compulsory subjects should be considered for the Best 5. The sixth additional subject should not be considered for the Best 5.

Similarly, for ICSE, subjects from the third group should not be considered.

For boards whose mark sheets have more than seven subjects, exclude the additional optional subjects. If there are three separate science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology), combine the marks of these three subjects as a single Science subject out of 100. Besides this, exclude the marks of optional additional subjects and record the marks of the best five subjects. Follow the same procedure for the boards of other states and other countries.

Marathi medium is showing for the Science stream, it should be English, right? What to do?

The Science stream is run in both Marathi medium and English medium schools. The medium shown on the portal for the Science stream is the medium of the school. Generally, in the Science stream, subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, IT, and Bifocal are taught in English only. Therefore, even if the medium of the Science stream is English or Marathi, the above four subjects are taught in English. Hence, it is fine if students select either of the mediums. However, more information can be obtained by contacting the concerned junior college for this.

While considering the marks of the best five subjects, can the extra marks obtained for excellence in arts and sports be considered?

The extra marks given to state board students for excellence in arts and sports in the 10th standard are not included in any single subject. According to the provisions of the Government Resolution dated May 10, 2025, the marks of the best 5 subjects will be considered for 11th admission. Therefore, the extra marks obtained for excellence in arts and sports cannot be included in the total for the merit list.

I am a student who passed the 10th examination of the State Board in March 2025, and my mother's name is not mentioned on my mark sheet. How can I register for admission?

State Board 10th standard students whose mother's name is not mentioned on the mark sheet or in the State Board information should enter XXXX in the place of the mother's name. After entering your seat number and XXXX for the mother's name, all your information will be available to you.

A wrong mobile number and wrong email ID have been entered in my admission application by mistake. How can I change it?

The facility to make necessary changes has been made available at the office of the Divisional Deputy Director of Education for students who want to change the mobile number/email ID mentioned in their admission application. For this, contact the office of the Divisional Deputy Director of Education of your division.

When can the marks of the additional subject in the 10th standard of the CBSE board be counted in the total?

The marks of the CBSE additional (6th) subject will be valid in the total in the following two situations:

1. If a student has failed in one of the language subjects out of the original five subjects and has taken a third language in the additional subject group and passed it, in that case, the marks of the passed language in the additional subject should be considered valid instead of the failed language among the above five subjects. The marks of five subjects should be combined by taking the four originally passed subjects and one additional language. (CBSE must have passed that student).
2. If a student has received an exemption from language subjects by the board and it is mentioned in the mark sheet, then the student will have only four out of the original five subjects. In such a case, if there is a subject in the additional group, it should be included, and the marks of five subjects (original four plus one additional) should be combined. (CBSE must have passed that student).

However, if an exemption has been taken for the English language subject or if the student has failed in English, such a student will not be able to take admission in the 11th standard. Also, students with a COMPARTMENTAL remark are not passed, so they

will also not be considered eligible for 11th admission. If CBSE board students have passed all five subjects in the basic subject group, the marks of the sixth additional subject should not be considered valid while totaling the marks for admission for such students. Only the marks of the basic five subjects should be combined.

What precautions should be taken while recording the marks in the ICSE examination for 11th admission?

CISCE board students should adopt the following procedure while recording their 10th standard marks. In the ICSE examination, students pass with 5, 6, or 7 subjects in this way: 3 from group one, 2 or 3 from group two, and 1 (optional) from group three.

While recording marks for 11th admission, the marks of any five subjects with the highest marks among the subjects in group one and group two should be considered. If a student has received an exemption from the language (second) subjects in group one by the board, or if the student has only five subjects altogether in group A and group B, then the marks of those five subjects should be mentioned. (CISCE must have passed that student).

If a student has only four subjects altogether in group one and group two and 1 subject in group three, then the marks of five subjects including the subject from group three should be mentioned. According to the passing criteria of the CISCE board, even if a student passes four subjects, they are considered passed. Therefore, even if there are only five subjects altogether in group A and group B, and the student has failed in one of them, the marks of those five subjects should still be mentioned (CISCE must have passed that student). The marks of subjects in group three should not be included.

If an exemption has been taken for the English language subject or if the student has failed in English, such a student will not be able to take admission in the 11th standard.

The deadline to apply for 11th admission has ended. So how can a new student apply?

In the 11th standard centralised online admission process, students are given a chance to apply online before every round. Therefore, if any student's Student Registration, Part-1, or Part-2 form is pending to be filled, the facility to fill the application will be available to that student at the beginning of the next admission round after the current admission round ends. At this time, new students can also enter the system by filling out an application. To understand the timeline regarding help in filling the application, one should carefully look at and understand the schedule of each round.

Can a student who has failed in 11th standard apply for 11th admission again? How?

If a student who has failed in 11th standard wants to take fresh admission in 11th standard in the same school or elsewhere, they can fill the application as 'Previously

Passed' like other students. At the time of admission, admission can be granted after verifying applicable documents like the 10th standard mark sheet and 11th standard school leaving certificate in this manner.
