Timing Techniques in Astrology attempt to grant insight into when certain events or themes might occur. Timing techniques in general have certain assumptions. One assumption is that not everything in a natal chart is active at the same time. Some timing techniques cover a broad span of time so techniques have been developed within them to cover shorter periods of time. So another assumption is that the broader the window the more general the significations and predictions will be, and the narrower the window the more it applies to that higher general level.

Quality is determined by the rulers of the signs, planets within those signs, aspects to those signs and so on just like any other quality review. Quality is also determined with the concept of Sect so they are defined by the Benefics or Malefics which vary between Diurnal and Nocturnal charts.

## **Transits**

Transits in Astrology refer to comparing the current position of planets and points in a Natal Chart to forecast trends and opportunities in the lifetime of what the Natal Chart refers to. By comparing these with the significations of planets houses and signs an astrologer hopes to identify periods of potential growth, challenge, or transition. The slower moving planets indicate more significant longer termed themes, while faster moving planets can signify shorter term influences.

To make a Transit Chart you will need an Inceptional or Natal Chart. The Transit chart is lined up with the Natal Chart along the signs. This tells you which planets points or calculations are transiting over positions in the Natal Chart. You can also compare which current positions are also aspecting to positions in the Natal Chart.

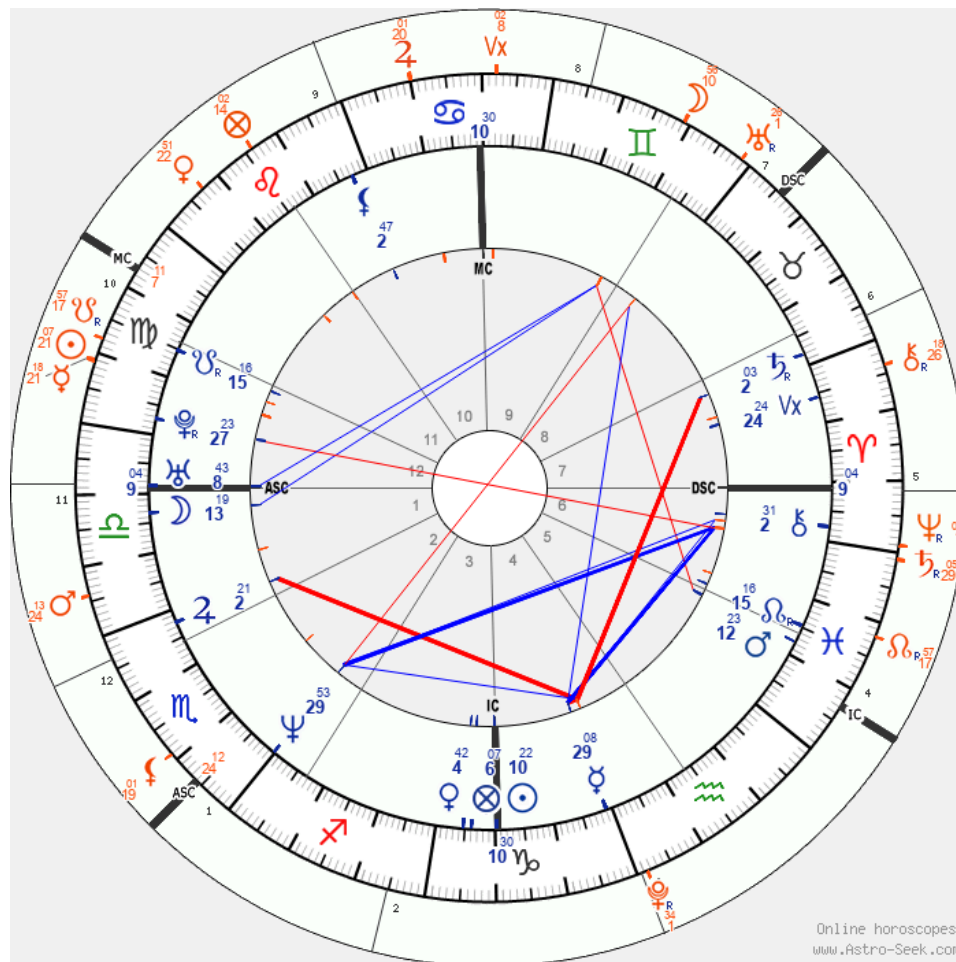
In this case the Transit over an entire sign and house is more broad and general than the aspects it is making it's like a metaphorical cosmic weather pattern. So whereas a Venus transit over the 11th house could indicate that the individual may just be more outwardly friendly during this time or friends and allies will be more prominent in what is going on during this period. An aspect from transiting Venus in this house to the birth planet Venus might be more significant in saying more such as making a new friend. An aspect from transiting Venus in this house to the birth planet Mars might say there could be a conflict with a friend or group of friends. But either way the cosmic weather pattern still might indicate that the individual may just be more outwardly friendly during this time or friends and allies will be more prominent in what is going on during this period.

For an example this Natal Chart is somebody born Jan 1st at midnight in New York City in the U.S.A.

The Transit Chart is for 13 September 2025 at Noon in the same city.



### Transiting Mars in the 1st House

This transiting Mars can signify a period full of energy which will be expressed in all areas of the life. There are no Aspects between the transiting Mars and objects in the Natal Chart.

### Transiting Pluto in the 4th House

This Transiting Pluto may signify an unconventional solution to a deep rooted family problem. This could involve a time trying to understand or explore family history, this could also be more tangible like moving the entire family to another place. To a period where the very values the family have been holding onto are transformed.

The Square aspect to Natal Saturn +0°28'S could be saying that something must change or be destroyed to make way for new beginnings. Just as possible could be the stripping away of false pretenses in connections to uncover something truly authentic. There is potential for challenges to foundations, relationship stressors, an increase of hard work. *[Intense Transformation and potential social structure disruption [Pluto in Aquarius] related to home*

*family roots inner foundation [4th house] clashing with established relationships values  
partnerships and commitments [Natal Saturn in Taurus in 7th House]*

Note here that Pluto transits can last for years to decades. This is why there are many timing techniques that can be used at the same time. The Aspect involved here perfected on Apr 19th 2024, again on May 16 2024, then on Jan 31st of 2025 as well as on August 17th 2025, and will again on Dec 7th 2025. So this could be saying its been rising and falling for years and might not see its conclusions until Pluto and Saturn separate by at least 1 degree

### Annual profections

Annual profections in astrology refer to which houses in a Natal or Inceptional Chart are most active for each year of the lifetime. They go in a relatively easy to follow pattern; during the 1st year House 1 is activated, during the 2nd year house 2 is activated and so on. This continues until year 13 where it starts over at the first house.

At the Sun return or birthday the house increases by 1.

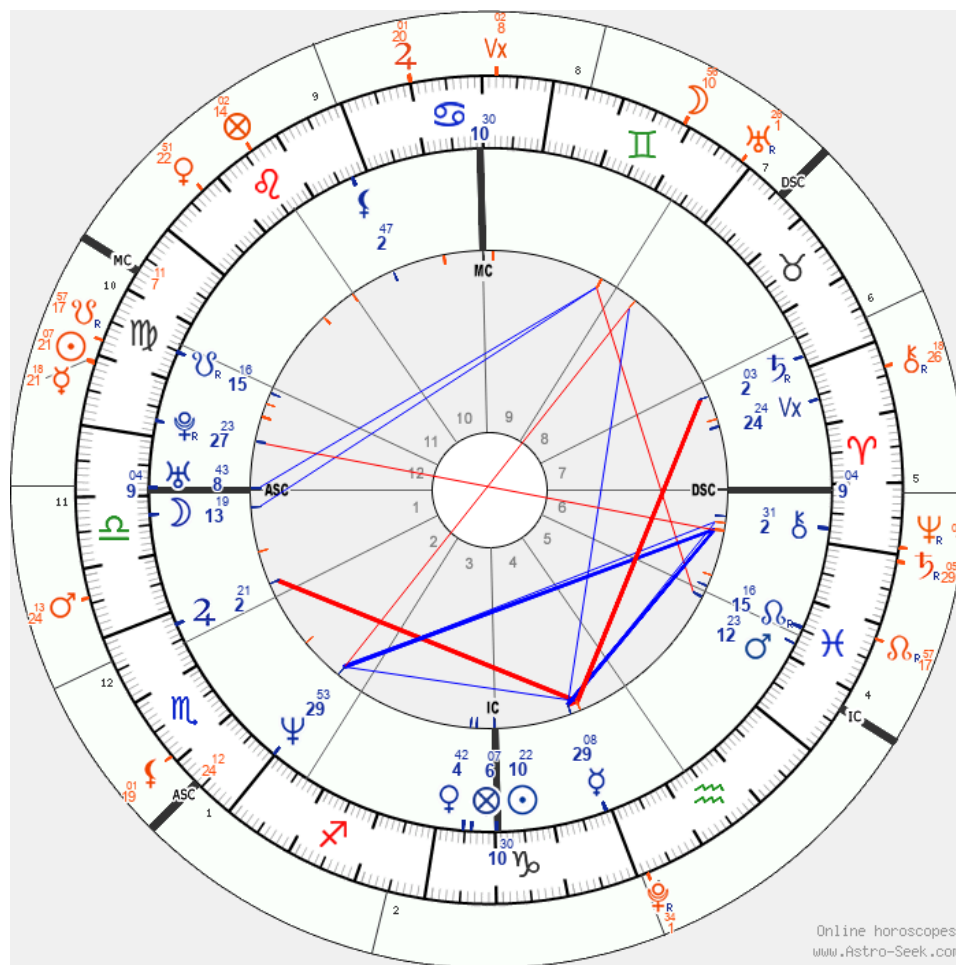

This could be thought that every year the Rising Sign moves forward by one whole sign house. You can also prefect your main luminary Sun in a Diurnal chart and Moon in a nocturnal chart using the same techniques.

The house that is being activated is the Time Lord for the year. So for example if the Rising Sign is Aries at Birth, Mars is the Time Lord for the entire year same for the 12th 24th 36th etc. During year two the rising sign moves to the sign of Taurus and Venus takes over as the Time Lord for the entire year same for the 13th, 25th, 37th etc..

The Annual Profecion can also be combined with the transit timing technique. For example if the Time Lord of the Year is Mars. Transiting Mars will activate certain signs and houses as it transits through those signs and houses. It will also make aspects to placements in the Natal Chart. And transits through the projected sign house of the year.

If we look back to our example transit chart from earlier



We see that the long term transit of Pluto in the 4th house squaring with Saturn in the 7th takes place over 2024-2025 when the owner of the Natal Chart is 54 and 55

Year 54 is a 7th house profecion year The Ruler of the Year is Mars

Year 55 is a 8th house profection year The Rule of the Year is Venus

The 8th house has no Natal planets in it but the Ruler of the Year Venus is located in Capricorn in the 3rd House Conjunct with Sun (5°39', Applying) Square Moon (8°36', Separating) Trine Saturn (2°39', Separating).

No transiting Planets aspecting Natal Venus

Transiting Venus is going over the 11th house Leo but not making aspects.

This might be saying that during this period of time friendship will bring them the most happiness. It can also mean theres a potential for financial gains from social networks. In this transit a romantic interest they may have made with someone may turn out to be more of a strong friendship bond that doesn't develop into deep intimacy.

So by applying these techniques we can get some insight into what this hypothetical persons general life may be like in the years of 2024 2025.

### **Secondary Progressions**

Secondary Progressions calculate when significant turning points may happen in the life.

The chart is progressed 1 day within an ephemeris and is thought to be activated as significations over the course of a year.

Notable changes are when planets change sign or move into retrograde or go direct.

The outer planets move so slow that they might not have any change in a progression chart Saturn for example may only move 3 degrees over a 90 year period with this technique.

Lets look at an ephemeris for the hypothetical person we have been looking at

In the period of the progressed Moon in the sign of Virgo, your primary goal was self-development.

When progressed Moon enters the sign of Libra, your attention shifts to the area of relationships with other people.

Libra is the 1st house of the Native

The progressed Moon in the first house brings the beginning of formation of a new identity, the new Self. After several years of cleaning emotional burdens and programs that are no longer useful during the progression of the Moon through the 12th house, we can emerge into the light again.

### Full Moon

Celebrating achievements, embracing gratitude, and engaging in self-reflection. It's a time to honor yourself and others and give thanks for the blessings in your life.



### Waning Gibbous

Releasing and letting go of old patterns or habits, reflecting on lessons learned, and expressing gratitude.



### Last Quarter

Reflecting on the past cycle, forgiving yourself and others, and letting go of remaining burdens.



### Waning Crescent

Surrendering to the natural flow of life, resting, and rejuvenating your energy.

### Sun Cycles

The fine details vary according to latitude and other local factors, but in general in the Northern Hemisphere :

The Tide of Sowing is the time between the spring equinox and the summer solstice (March 21 to June 21, is a time of beginnings and of growth;

The Tide of Reaping is the time between the summer solstice and the fall equinox (June 21 to September 23), a time of completion and fruitfulness;

The Tide of Planning is the time between the fall equinox and the winter solstice (September 23 to December 23), a time of preservation and taking stock;

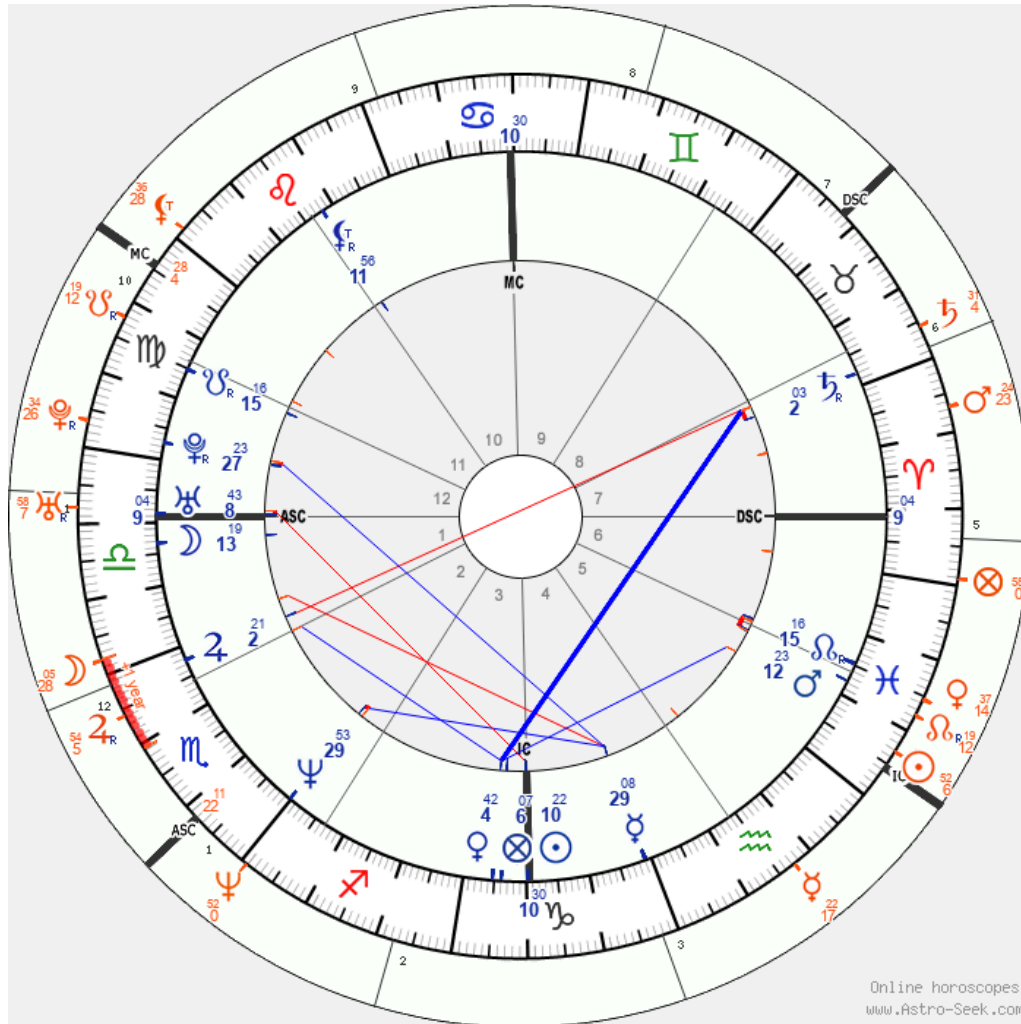
The Tide of Destruction is the time between the winter solstice and the spring equinox (December 23 to March 21), a time of destruction and purification.

Other aspects are considered as well between the faster moving planets like Mercury and Venus.

### Zodiacal releasing

Zodiacal Releasing is an ancient timing technique in astrology for the Hellenistic Tradition that comes from Vettius Valens. In its simplest terms it divides the life into chapters based upon the movement of zodiac signs. Zodiacal releasing starts from typically the ☿ Lot of Fortune (related to external circumstances and fortune) or the ☼ Lot of Spirit (related to ones actions or life's direction).

This begins at the level of decades but subsequent levels divide by 12 into years and then further divide into months and even down into days.

Using a book metaphor this would be volumes followed by chapters followed by paragraphs followed by sentences. In this article I am going to go over Peak Periods which are periods that are angular to the Lot being studied. These periods are marked by heightened activity and importance and subsequent levels have signification too just on a smaller scale. Note that Peak Periods do not reveal quality.

Quality is determined by the rulers of the signs, planets within those signs, aspects to those signs and so on just like any other quality review. Quality is also determined with the concept of Sect so they are defined by the Benefics or Malefics which vary between Diurnal and Nocturnal charts.

There is a specific transition point in a subperiod that is of a special interest and has a special rule. This is called the Loosing of the Bond. What that means is in level 2 when one is considering years if the releasing makes a complete revolution around the zodiac before Level 1 enters into the next zodiac sign the special rule is activated. Instead of restarting at the beginning of the Zodiacal order it moves to the zodiac sign straight across from it and continues in zodiacal order from there. This signifies a major transition point in the life path. Note the Loosing of the Bond happens between levels 2 and 3 but on level 3 and after it loses weight and becomes more of a mundane transition.

Zodiacal Releasing factored in the ebb and flow of life events, so they could pinpoint when certain themes or challenges will be most prominent. Or in other words when the potential in the Natal chart is fulfilled or active. As such this means what is in the Natal chart is not available all the time and this method helps one to identify when things are available or when they are challenging.

First there are a few things to keep in mind in Zodiacal releasing years are given 360 days months are given 30 days. I could speculate on Plato's Theory of Forms here as to why this is so, but it could just be because it's simple to divide those values by 12.

### Calculating Zodiacal Releasing Periods








First one would determine what sign there ☽ Lot of Fortune (health accidents, the body, that which befalls you)

or ☼ Lot of Spirit (Career, overall life direction, actions) was in depending on what areas of the life one wants to study. Releasing from other lots and points are possible but Vettius Valens only covers the 2 lots in his works.

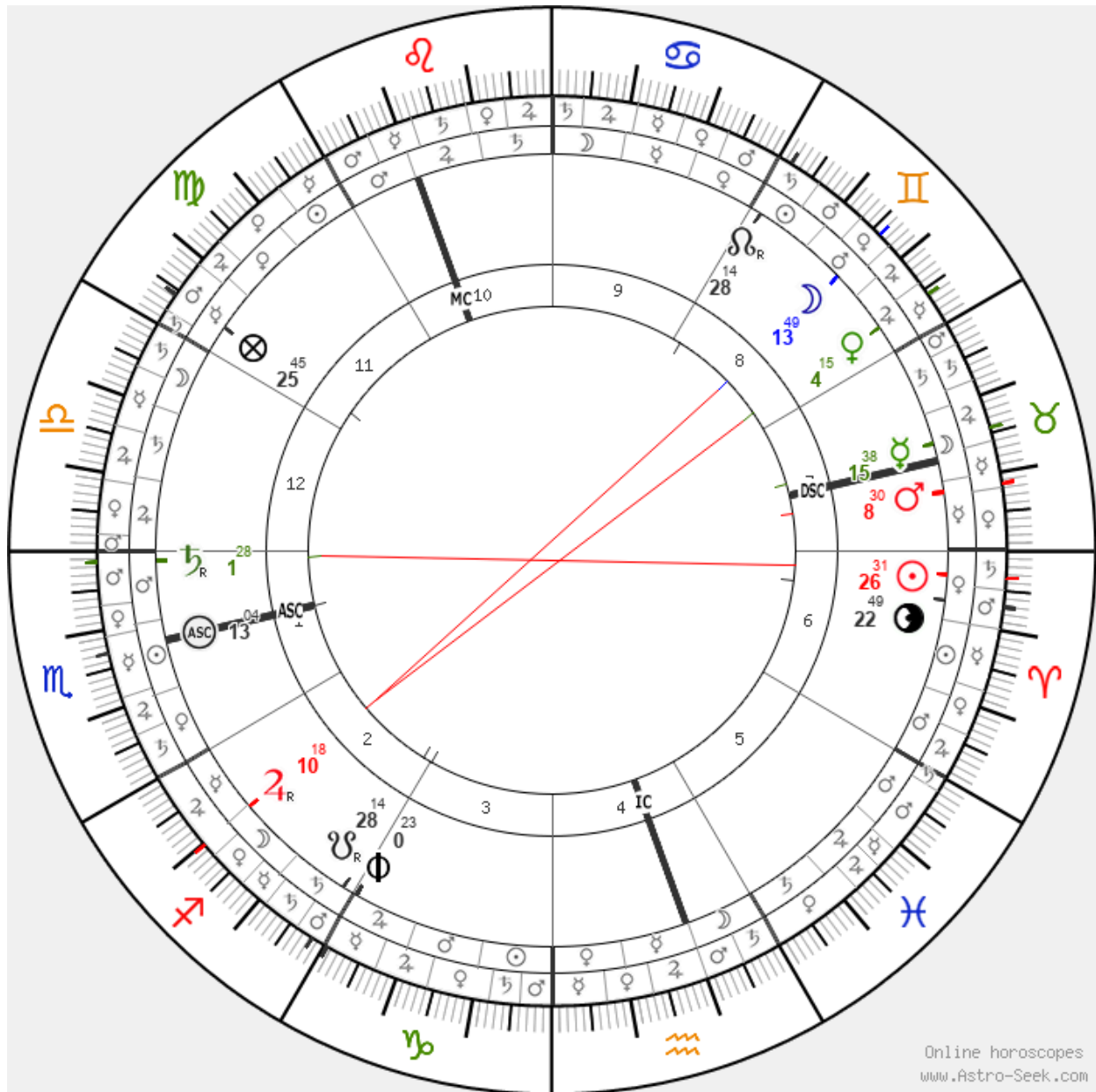
When releasing from any Lot or point the Lot or point you are releasing from becomes house 1.

### Peak Periods

The signs that are angular from the Lot of Fortune are more active and important. Meaning when activated they should coincide with periods of heightened importance and activity. But they are not necessarily positive or negative, We will look into that later right now we are just determining the period of time that stand out in a persons chronology, not only in general periods (Level 1) but also in sub periods (Level 2)

Lot of Fortune = Virgo

Square to Fortune = Sagittarius

Oposing Fortune = Pisces

Square to Fortune = Gemini

(Notice how these are all Cadent Signs, the modality should be the same when considering angularity)

Everything ebbs and flows so the signs that come before peak periods build up to prepare for the peak, The sign after carries forward and brings completion to these times. These clusters are known as Angular Triads.

Since the release is from the Lot of Fortune the lot of Fortune is considered the 1st house

### **Quality of a Period**

Quality is primarily determined by:

- Planets in the activated sign
- Planets aspecting the activated sign by square or opposition
- The condition of the ruler of the sign

Benefics and Malefics:

- Dictate the subjective experience of the period as more positive or negative
- The starting Lot released from provides the context
- Day Chart: Jupiter most positive Mars most negative
- Night Chart: Venus most positive, Saturn most Negative
- Signs angular to most negative planet experienced as most negative.
- Signs angular to most positive planet experienced as most positive.
- Sign based aspects from the benefits and malefics

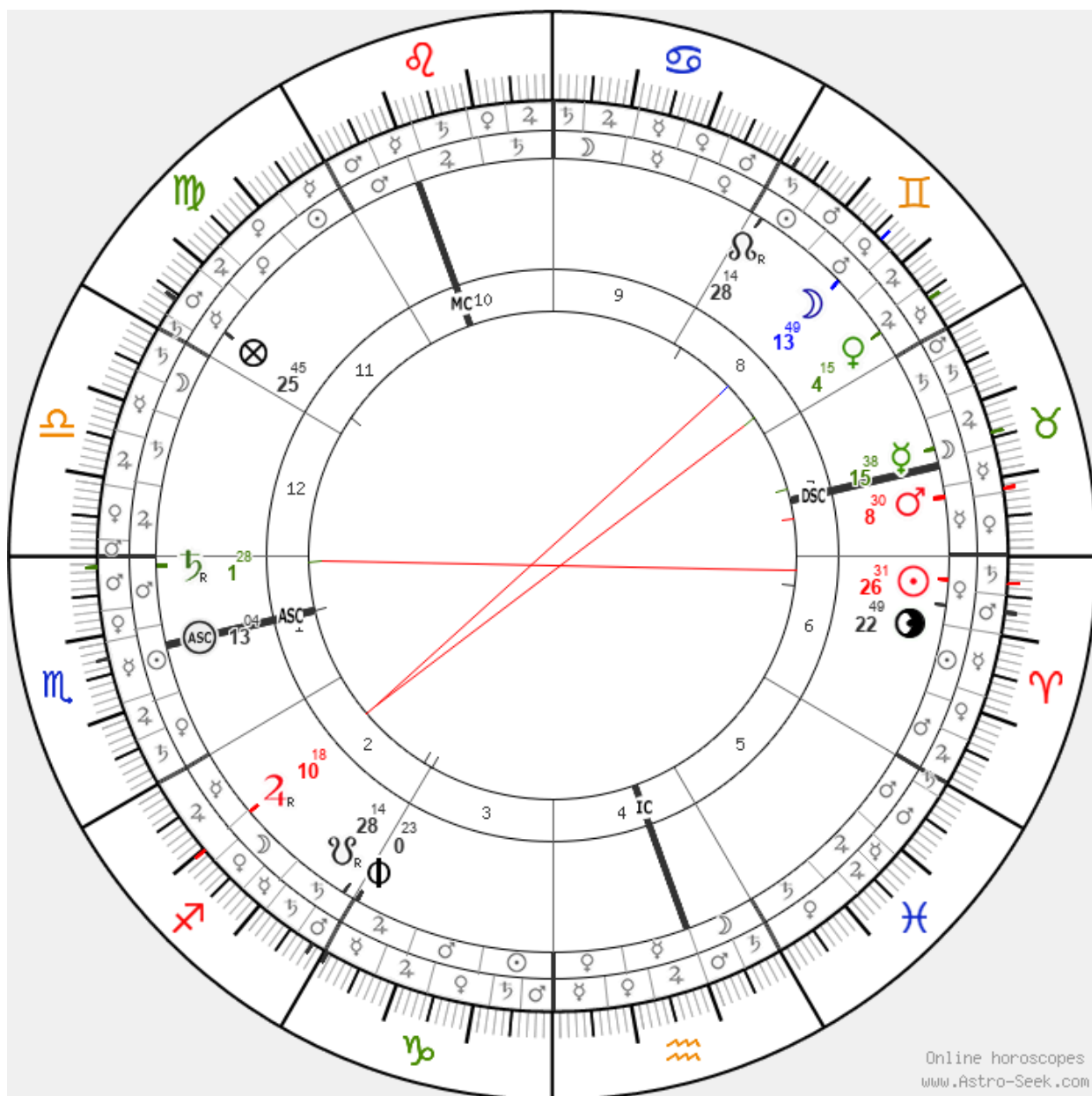
See where most positive and negative planets fall in the Angular Triads

- Is the most positive planet or the most negative planet angular from the Lot of Fortune?
- Are Benefics activated in the build up period or the cool down period?
- Are Malefics in this build up period or cool down phase?

### **Loosing of the Bond**

Always marks a major transition and happen only a few times in the average lifespan

- In Spirit it would be a major transition in the career and life path
- In Fortune sometimes a transition in body, health or circumstance.



Lets look at my chart to determine quality of the peak periods

Virgo: No planets in Sign. No Square or Opposing Aspects, The Ruler of Virgo is Venus which is in Gemini opposing Jupiter in Sagittarius where Jupiter has its Rulership

Sagittarius: has Jupiter within the sign. Opposes Venus in Gemini, The Ruler of Sagittarius is Jupiter.

Pisces: No planets in Sign. No Square or Opposing Aspects. The Ruler of Pisces is Jupiter which is in Sagittarius where Jupiter has its Rulership opposing Venus in Gemini.

Gemini: Moon in Gemini, Venus in Gemini. Opposes Jupiter in Sagittarius. The Ruler of Gemini is Mercury which is in Taurus.

Now lets look at the Benefics and Malefics:

Benefic:

I have a nocturnal chart so Venus in Gemini is the most positive planet

Angular signs to Gemini are Virgo Sagittarius and Pisces and these occur during my peak periods.

Jupiter is the other Benefic and it is in Sagittarius where it has Rulership

Angular signs to Sagittarius are Pisces Gemini and Virgo Sagittarius and these occur during my peak periods.

Malefic:

I have a Nocturnal Chart so Saturn in Scorpio is the most negative planet
