

Flip (formerly Flipgrid) - General Information

Flip (<u>flip.com</u>) is a video discussion platform. Teachers can use Flip by itself or integrate it in Canvas assignments. The full version of Flip is now free for everyone!

Group

- A Group holds your questions and student video responses.
- You can have one group or multiple groups. If you are integrating Flip into Canvas, you can
 use just one group or you may want to use multiple groups (Eg. class periods, topics taught,
 club, etc.)
- If you will use only one group, name it something generic such as Mrs. Smith.

Topics

- Topics are the questions you want students to respond to with their recorded videos.
- In a group, you can have as many topics as you choose.

Student Submissions

- Students can submit up to a 10 minute video (teachers choose max time) and an unlimited number of times.
- Students need to sign in with their Google accounts. **Note:** If you are using Canvas and create an assignment using the Flip external tool, students do not have to sign in.
- Students can submit through Canvas.
- Students can reply via video to other students (if allowed by teacher).
- Teachers can choose to moderate student videos and whether or not to make them visible to other students.

Notes about Canvas and Flip Integration

- Use One Flip account for all of your Canvas Courses: You can integrate a Flip account with multiple Canvas courses.
- **New Topics:** Creating a new Flip Assignment in Canvas creates a new Topic in Flip, so there is no need to create the new Topic in Flip first.
- **Speedgrader:** For submissions to be integrated with Speedgrader, students MUST access the Flip topic from an **Assignment**.
 - *Important Note:* If students use Flip on the navigation sidebar, their videos will not be submitted to Speedgrader, so it is recommended that you **do not** add Flip to the navigation sidebar.

Flip Email Notifications from Students

By default, when you create a Group in Flip, you will receive email notifications when students submit videos. To turn this off, do the following:

- 1. Sign in to www.flip.com
- 2. In the upper left corner, click the Flip logo
- 3. At the top of the screen, click on Groups
- 4. Do not click on it, but locate the **group for your class**. It will have the same name as in Canvas.
- 5. To the right of your group name, click the **Pencil icon**
- 6. In the top right, click **Settings**
- 7. In the **Notifications** area, to the right of **Allow notifications for members** click the **toggle button** to turn it off
- 8. Click Save Changes button
