Mini Stocks will match Mini Stock weight rule of 1 LB per c.c. of engine after race with driver - minimum weight 2,000 LBS) • Street tires or Hoosier takeoffs • Fuel may be regular pump gas (racing fuel not required) • Class will be managed with a 19 second BREAKOUT RULE (monitored by Transponder on Westhold system) • Head/neck restraint device is mandatory – SAFETY is paramount • All participants must be at least 12 years of age but no more than 18 years of age on the date of the first weekly race of the season – FIRST YG Event of 2024 is set for Friday, May 17th • There is a 2 caution rule in this division, if a driver is involved in 2 cautions during the feature, he/she may be black flagged for the remainder of that event • Minor Release Forms are mandatory before being allowed to compete at any event, including practices and race events (until submitted). Must be completed by legal guardian • AMS Reserves the right to ask for proof of birth certificate 2.8.24
