President Update

Fundraising Update

- Brooklyn Nets vs Pistons tix -- can go on sale after Bagel Breakfast. 30 tickets committed for Sunday, November 3. Attendance may be an issue with 3-day weekend.
- Looking into FC tickets.
- New Gear ordered; will update ms447store.com after bagel breakfast
- Discussion of Fundraising objectives for 6th, 7th and 8th grade trips. Consensus: Parent trip fees are separate fees; fundraising for trips is a part of a school-wide general fund, part of the direct appeal. PTA aims to bridge gap between parents' fees and costs of trip for all children. \$15,000 allocated from general funds, additional \$15K fundraising from families across grades during the year for trips. PTA confident can cover any gap given similar checking account levels from September '23 to September '24.
 - PTA will create Camp Bernie page on Zeffy site for 6th grade parents trip fees.
 - 6th grade additional funds likely to be modest – movie trips, etc – and can be covered from other principal or pta sources; however, extra trip funds if any could be allocated there.

Treasurer Update:

Discussion of \$1,500 budgeted amounts for talent teachers; teachers are already reaching out about funding, including art supplies and piano tuning.
