- Monday - Friday, 6:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.
- Childcare for children in Kindergarten through age 12.
- Registration materials can be found onsite and at this [link](#).
- Breakfast and hot lunch is provided onsite. A weekly menu is available.
- Distance learning will be supported at this site. Bring your device (labeled with first and last name) and headphones.
- Free for children to attend.
- All children and staff will complete a quick health assessment upon arrival.
- If your child requires medication, please bring medication in the original container. Please allow for a few extra minutes at drop off to complete medication paperwork.
- All children should bring proper outdoor gear. Children will go outside daily.

- Cost: \$30/day for members and \$36/day for non-members. Scholarships are available.
