

Keystone Pathway Graduation Requirements for the Class of 2024

In accordance with Pennsylvania's Act 158 of 2018, beginning with the graduating class of 2023 and beyond, students must meet statewide graduation requirements in one of four pathways. You are able to meet the following pathway based on the scores you received on the Keystone exams.

Pathway #1 – You achieve Proficient or Advanced on the 3 Keystones (Literature, Biology, and Algebra).

Pathway #2 - You earn Proficient or Advanced on at least one Keystone exam AND scored at least Basic on the other two Keystone exams AND have a composite score of at least 4452.
