Activity Fee 2018

In 2017 we introduced an activity fee after working out all the costs that you incur over the year at school. We have reviewed this system after finding that it worked very well and we will use this system once again this year. We will do our very best to keep within these costs - although there are a couple of exclusions which are outlined on this sheet.

For parents of our year 5 - 8 parents we have had to increase the cost of traveling to the weekly Winter Sport Competition as costs for buses have increased.

School costs explained:

Donation: The donation is \$25 per child per term - up to two children per family. This is used to cover the shortfall required to run the school that is not covered by MOE funding. This is a tax deductible donation and is not included in the activity fee. **It will be listed separately on your account and clearly as a donation.**

The activity fee is explained in detail below - please note that it differs for different age groups. It also excludes swimming lessons and costs of camps. *Please note there are no camps being held in 2018.*
