LEGALLY SPEAKING: In South Carolina, if a tree falls on you, it is your responsibility to clean up (unless you have alerted your neighbor in writing that you are concerned about that specific tree). The property line is where the responsibility changes...some trees are shared once they've fallen.

DO YOU HAVE A TREE YOU WOULD LIKE TO REMOVE? ALL upright trees must be reviewed, approved and logged in our tree removal log. Rick and I review trees daily...just call the office to get a work order generated. If it's a no-brainer, you'll have a permit the next day in most cases.
