Whereas; we forgot to stop that in the criminal code

The following shall be added to the criminal code:

## Article 28b - Resisting Arrest

- §1. The crime of resisting arrest shall be defined as "using any means to circumvent or otherwise avoid the lawful arrest of oneself or someone else".
  - §1.1 Using one's position to argue against or deny the arrest of a criminal in an attempt to avoid a violation of Article 31 of the criminal code shall not constitute resisting arrest.
- §2. Use of an alternate account to resist arrest may be prosecuted under Article 19 of the criminal code.
- §3. A ban may be used in cases of resisting arrest, but must be lifted for the defendant to be able to attend trial or if the Attorney General or their subordinates choose to stop seeking prosecution of the defendant.
- §4. Sentences available for this offense are to be between one day and lifetime ban from SimDemocracy and its associated discord server.

The following shall also be added to the criminal code:

## Article 73b - Abuse of Vulnerability

- §1. The crime of Abuse of Vulnerability is to be defined as "using a channel labeled as a judgement free zone, and/or a place to vent in an attempt to disparage, harass, or otherwise aggressively confront someone who is attempting to use the channel for its intended purpose".
- §2. The crime of Abuse of Vulnerability is to be prosecuted at the request of the victim, or at the discretion of the state if there is no clear target.

- §3. No one may be punished for Abuse of Vulnerability if it is determined that the defendant was also attempting to use the channel for its intended purpose when they made the supposedly criminal statements.
- §4. Sentences available for this offense is to be a ban or mute between one week and a lifetime from SimDemocracy and its associated discord server.

The following shall be added to Article 6 of the Criminal Code

§7. If the determined sentence is equal to, or less than the amount of time that the defendant had already served in a mute, arrest, or pre-emptive ban it is to be determined that the defendant had already served their sentence, and the defendant is to be released.
