0.1 More, 0.1 Less

Materials: Paper, pencil, digit cards

1.	Each	player	draws	a	row	of	10	lines.

- 2. Place the digit cards face down in a stack.
- 3. The first player draws 2 cards and arranges the digits to make a number less than 1.
- 4. The player must then either add 0.1 or subtract 0.1 from the number and place the answer on one of the 10 lines. Once a number is placed on a line, it cannot be moved.
- 5.On that player's next turn, he or she must draw 2 more digit cards, add or subtract 0.1, and place that number on one of the lines. The numbers must be in order from least to greatest.
- 6. If a player cannot place a number, he or she gets a tally mark.
- 7. The goal of the game is to have the fewest tally marks.
- 8. Continue until everyone has filled his or her rows, or until no one else can place a number.
