

0.1 More, 0.1 Less

Materials: Paper, pencil, digit cards

1. Each player draws a row of 10 lines.

2. Place the digit cards face down in a stack.

3. The first player draws 2 cards and arranges the digits to make a number less than 1.

4. The player must then either add 0.1 or subtract 0.1 from the number and place the answer on one of the 10 lines. Once a number is placed on a line, it cannot be moved.

5. On that player's next turn, he or she must draw 2 more digit cards, add or subtract 0.1, and place that number on one of the lines. The numbers must be in order from least to greatest.

6. If a player cannot place a number, he or she gets a tally mark.

7. The goal of the game is to have the fewest tally marks.

8. Continue until everyone has filled his or her rows, or until no one else can place a number.
