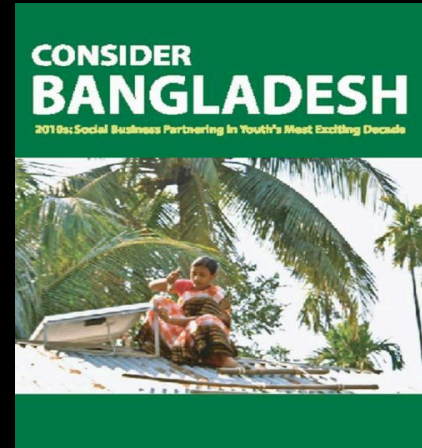

Executive Summary
The 'Youth Entrepreneurship & Jobs' Framework is a national job creation and employment model in South Africa which through leveraging government support and a network of private sector partners will:

1. educate **14-million school learners per annum** in entrepreneurship, higher order thinking skills, creativity, problem-solving, risk-taking, work ethics, and social entrepreneurship and empathy
2. **630,000 youth per annum** in the technical college (FETs) system in entrepreneurship and small business creation with supporting tools
3. **support 3-million small businesses** with essential services through a national mobile phone strategy to create opportunities for unemployed youth, and
4. in addition will reach a **million-youth per annum** via three mobile platforms.

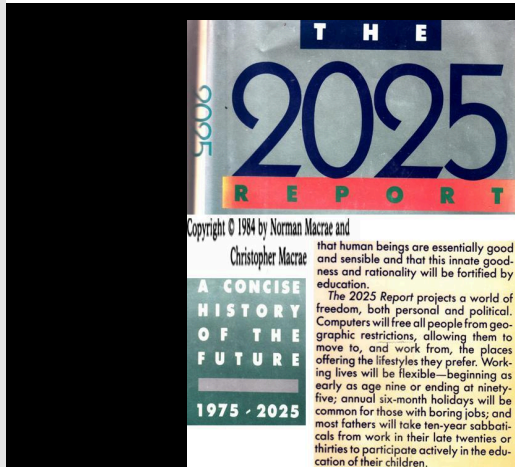


