Safety Corner - Bud Glass, AMA Safety Officer

Some pilots have arbitrarily decided they can fly from locations other than the designated and approved pilots' boxes due to wind direction and/or speed changes. WRONG! The club went to great lengths and expense to get the current airfield and pilots' box layout approved by the park and the Safety Committee, including relocating one of the new pilots' boxes that was the source of several near-misses. Our Operating and Safety Rule manual rules state it clearly. All pilots must fly from the designated pilots' boxes except for take-off and landings. If you cannot fly and maintain control of your aircraft in the existing wind conditions from one of the designated pilots' boxes, you should not fly. Others see this and think it is OK for anyone to fly from wherever they want. It simply is NOT OK, no excuses. Follow the posted safety rules or find somewhere else to fly.





A new helipad has been added to the south end of the new diagonal runway. Only **one helipad may be used at the same time**, and heli and multi-rotor drone operations are prohibited from anywhere other than one of the three designated helipads.
