- Helping students develop more positive academic perspectives and aspirations.
- Boosting students' self-esteem and resiliency, and decreasing risky behaviors.
- Helping students relax their minds and improve their confidence levels.
- Increasing students' engagement with their school, which can decrease the likelihood of dropping out and school failure.
