



Manos Unidas International Cusco: Festival of the Sun Tour June 21- June 29, 2023



Trip Overview

This unique tour dives deep into the heart of the imperial city and the vibrant Andean culture. We start the tour with a traditional ceremony to honor mother earth and all our relations on the sacred day of the Winter solstice: June 21. The next few days are spent exploring the ancient city, nearby ruins, Andean foothills, neighboring communities and participating in local festivities as the city anticipates the Festival of the Sun on June 24.

The tour then goes into the heart of the Sacred Valley of the Incas and winds through local indigenous communities where we will walk through the land and learn with a local family. We will rest our heads in a magical place surrounded by 360 degree views of ancient peaks respected by the locals as the guardians of the valley before taking our journey to the famed Macchu Picchu.

We will enjoy a train ride with gorgeous views of lush landscape and spend the day walking the lands once called the great city. An evening soak in the local mineral hot pools will be a great end to our long journey before heading back to the Sacred Valley.

Our last day will be spent visiting a local social project serving children with disabilities in the surrounding communities.

We will have a day to rest and recover in the gorgeous valley before heading back for our departure home.
