Required Materials

- Pencils: HB, 2B, and 6B
- Plastic eraser
- Fine point Micron Pens (.05) or Fine Tip Sharpie
- Lightweight paper drawing pad or newsprint pad. The recommended sizes are 11 inches by 14 inches, 14 inches by 17 inches, or 18 inches by 24 inches.

Recommended Materials

- Tracing paper - 11 inches by 14 inches
- Basic set of colored art markers plus a flesh tone
- White colored pencil or white gel pen
- Bristol board 100-pound smooth (11 inches by 14 inches) or marker paper.

Note: The instructor will demonstrate color rendering in class, but it will not be required for the final project.

Optional Materials

- Pictures and images from magazines and catalogs
- Watercolors or watercolor pencils
- Artists' colored pencils
- Ink
- Gouache paint
- Other media you are interested in using
- Appropriate paper for chosen media

Note: Be sure to purchase "artist" supplies instead of "student" or regular supplies. Regular markers, colored pencils, etc., will not give you the same results and flexibility. Art supply employees are usually a good source of knowledge when looking for a good brand or the right paper to go with the media of your choice.

Markers

- Prismacolor Double Ended Art Markers, choose from chisel tip or brush tip (\$3.00-\$5.00 ea.)

Colored pencils

- Berol Prismacolor, Faber-Castell, Derwent

Other media

- Watercolor pencils (Caran D'Ache, Faber-Castell, Derwent)
- Watercolors (Daniel Smith or Grumbacher watercolors, Windsor Newton or Daniel Smith brushes)
- Soft (artists') pastels (Rembrandt or Windsor Newton)
