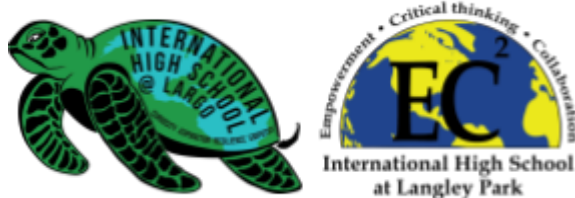

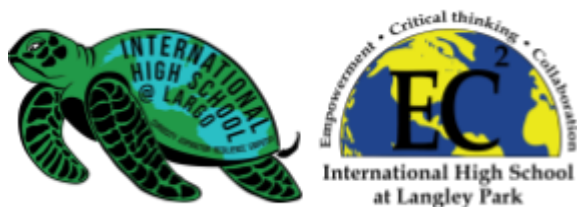

WHAT'S DIFFERENT IN OUR SCHOOLS?
