5 mins	Introduction:	
	Introduce the topic - Inside Appliances	
	Today we will learn the signs for some appliances we use in our homes everyday. David teaches us the signs and uses them in a sentence. Which ones do you use the most? Can you practise using these signs and how you use them?	
	 (Start of Lesson) Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria. Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary. 	
10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch the video	Lesson 12 video
	Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time.	
	Signs taught: lamp, heater, charger, dishwasher, vacuum, fan, kettle, rice cooker, iron, clothes dryer, hairdryer.	
5 mins	 Inside Appliances Matching Game Students sit in tables in pairs or small groups to play the Matching Game (match pictures of signs taught) The cards are placed face down on the table and mixed up. Each student takes a turn, turning over 2 cards in an attempt to match them. As they turn each card they sign what is on the card or fingerspell the word if it's a word. When they find a match they keep the cards. The game continues until all cards are gone. 	See Appliances Matching Game Sheets below.

	 The matches include words and pictures or associated pictures e.g. rug and vacuum cleaner, wet hair and hairdryer, mug and kettle. 	
15 mins	Activity:Practise the signs togetherMatching Game	
5 mins	 Reflection with Students: (Select from the following options) How many of these signs look like what they represent (signs) in Auslan? Would you have guessed some of them without being taught? These are 'iconic' signs. Do you have and use many of these appliances at home? How did the Matching Game go? Did you get any pairs and were you able to use the signs?
