

# Marysville High School Band Boosters

## Meeting Minutes

May 19, 2022

Laura Cusick called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm in person and via Zoom Conferencing.

### SECRETARY'S REPORT

- Amy Keller summarized the meeting minutes from 4/21/22 as technical issues posting those minutes to the website.
- A motion was made to accept the secretary's report as summarized. The motion passed unanimously.

### TREASURER REPORT

- Fees continue to roll in, improving the checking account balance. We have had a lot of craft show vendor fees rolling in.
- CDs are getting ready to mature. We have four CDs
  - Two are earmarked for uniform replacement.
  - The other two are unrestricted.
- We received a check for \$11,211.60 from the SnapRaise fundraiser!
- A motion was made to accept the treasurer's report. The motion was passed unanimously.

- Upcoming restaurant fundraisers:
  - Whits: waiting to hear back for a July fundraiser.

  - Jersey Mike's will give 50% of the proceeds on Thursday, August 4th. You must state you are with the band to get the donation.
  - Bostons: waiting to hear back on the final date. The plan is for 10% of qualifying purchases when the flyer is handed to the wait staff.

  - Wendys (on west 5th) community night: September 9th, would receive 10% from ALL sales.
  - Working on a summer activity fundraiser (e.g., Get Air)
