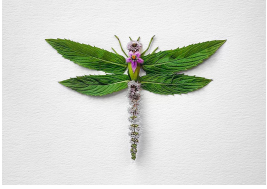


Craft and Art Class for CHEER 2021 Spring Camp

Time Slot: 1:00- 1:30pm

Class Materials:

Monday 	• Paper, leaves (grass and tree bark is also ok), and crayons or colored pencils, we will be making imprints on paper. • Also, I will ask the students to prepare for a special craft we will be doing on Friday, the parents will need to prepare flower petals (leaves and grass will also do) and a thick heavy book. • If students do not have the materials needed, I will prepare an origami craft for them to do, all they need is paper.
Tuesday 	• Rocks, paint (acrylic) or crayons, paint brushes, a cup of water, and a paper towel. We will be painting rocks. • If students do not have the materials needed, I will prepare an origami craft for them to do, all they need is paper.
Wednesday 	• Leaves, flower petals, grass, anything they can find in the backyard. They will also need glue (preferably glue in a bottle) and maybe scissors. We will be making animals out of plants. • If students do not have the materials needed, I will prepare an origami craft for them to do, all they need is paper.
Thursday 	• Sticks, string, and glue, we will be making picture frames for the special craft we will be doing on Friday. • If students do not have the materials needed, I will prepare an origami craft for them to do, all they need is paper.
Friday	• Flower petals or leaves that we prepared on Monday, glue, paper, and the picture frame we made on Thursday, we will be making pressed petals and leaf art. • If students do not have the materials needed, I will prepare an origami craft for them to do, all they need is paper.

Class description: I will be teaching natural art, art made out of plants, and other things. The day before every class, I will tell the students what they need to prepare (like stuff from their backyards and kitchens) so they will be ready the next day when we actually do the craft. The crafts will be simple things like painting rocks or making picture frames out of sticks. We will do crafts like making animals out of plants, imprints of leaves, pressed leaves and flowers, and bean art. Ariel will be helping me teach, so I will also tell her what she needs to prepare for the crafts as well. If students don't have all the materials they need, I will prepare another craft for them to do.

Class Details (each class):

3/29/21: Students listened very well, although most of them didn't pre-prepare their materials before class, they all did the craft very nicely. As expected most students don't have the materials they need for Friday's craft, so I will just teach them a simple origami.
