QUIZ COMPETITION

Dept. of Mathematics had conducted quiz competition on basic mathematical concepts and formulae on 17.08.2019 to inculcate interest and competitive spirit in mathematics subject. Students from all the three years have participated in the competition. It was conducted from 2:30 P.M 4:30P.M in Projector room, IM.P.C, IB.Z.C classrooms.

The competition was conducted to mathematics background students. It was conducted in three levels. Level-1 comprised of easy and basic level questions from ratios, arithmetic, functions, differentiation, and integration. A total of 19 teams each consisting of 4 members participated in Level-1. The first five highest scoring teams moved to level-2. The Level -2 comprised of hard level questions from derivations and analysis of mathematics. The winners of level-2 participated in final round.
