

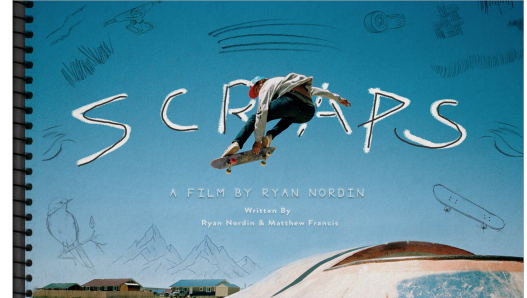
SCRAPS Film Casting (Bridger)

- Attach your resume, social media links, professional portfolio, or acting reels
- To your email, attach your Self-Tape:
 - Please dress as you envision your character, memorize your lines, and do each scene in one take. Soak in the quiet moments between the lines and *live* the scenes.
 - Film horizontally on a tripod. Have appropriate lighting with the light source in front of you and behind the camera. Stand in front of a plain background.
 - Having a behind-the-camera reader to narrate the opposite character’s dialogue for your scenes is helpful.

In your self-tape, please cut together the following content pieces:

- State your name, age, location, and which character you are reading for.
 - a. Read for the attached scene: **pg. 53-57: [Bonfire Scene](#)**
- Share how you resonate with the story of SCRAPS and why you’d like to be involved.
