Background

The Story Kitchen (TSK) is a not-for-profit-distributing company registered in September 2012 under the Companies Act, 2006 Nepal. We envision a society, where every woman's voice is heard, her existence is accepted, her work is accounted, and her contribution is valued. Our mission is to create a safe space for herstories and amplify the experiences of women in our history. We are driven by the passionate belief that sharing and listening to the stories of women can build the movement and it helps to ignite social change. In short, TSK is a space to amplify Herstory.

The Story Kitchen is looking for a **Multimedia Reporter** for its web-based platform www.sandhaann.com which blends journalism, history and narrative practice with a focus on Herstory documentation. This position requires a strong understanding of Nepal's intersectional feminist movements, strong multimedia production skills and a passion for creating multimedia content and stories

In close coordination with and guidance from Editorial Coordinator, Multimedia Reporter will take lead in the production of impactful stories achieving the goal and objectives of TSK and Sandhaann (सन्धान). Some major responsibilities of the Multimedia Reporter but not limited will include:

Major Responsibilities

- Develop concepts and ideas for multimedia content that align with the organization's branding and messaging.
- Research and produce impactful stories through written articles, videos, photos and other digital formats focusing on Nepal's intersectional feminist movements

- Produce creative and engaging multimedia contents from research based articles and herstory documentation
- Lead the design and production of audio and visual materials, infographics and promotional content to support advocacy campaigns and organizational events
- Create engaging content for TSK's social media platforms to increase visibility and audience engagement
- Travel to collect stories, audios, visuals and interviews, contributing to the development of a comprehensive collection of feminist historical documentation.
- Collaborate with a diverse network of individuals and resources to gather information and stories

Required Qualifications and Experience

- A Bachelor's Degree in Journalism, gender studies, history, or any other related faculty with at least 3 years of work experience in similar responsibility and same working issue.
- Proven experience of putting feminist perspectives in writing for journalism and research.
- Excellent in written Nepali and English, with proficiency in grammar, vocabulary and style
- Strong networking skills and the ability to establish connections with individuals and organizations in the field.
- Excellent skills in photography, Videography and multimedia production
- Proficiency in using multimedia editing and design tools/software such as Adobe Premiere, Photoshop, Canva and Indesign
- Experience in creating engaging social media content
- Understanding of Nepal's intersectional feminist movements, gender justice and social inclusion.
- Leadership skills and the ability to work independently as well as within a team.

The application must submit:

1. **Cover letter**, including **expected basic monthly Salary** and **earliest date of joining**.
2. Updated **Curriculum Vitae** with name and contact information of at least **two referees**.
