**EXTENDED DEADLINE ARRIVES**

**MINIMUM SCORE MET:** Congratulations! Continue into your linked student teaching placement.

**MINIMUM SCORE NOT MET:** You have two options to choose from:

- Continue retaking the Content Test until you meet the minimum score requirement. Afterwards, contact the Office of Field Experience to discuss Student Teaching placement options.
- Meet with your coach/advisor to discuss a change to the [Applied Educational Studies program](#) which allows you to graduate with a degree in education, but without licensure.



- Register for and complete the Discover Course.

<p><a href="#">ILTS Policy</a> requires students to wait a minimum of 14 days between test attempts, meaning that students can attempt the exam twice in one month. Generally, students will receive their detailed score reports within 2 – 3 weeks of taking the test.
