September - December	 Register on the Bearcat Advantage Website using the login information sent to your @bcbearcats email <u>http://bearcats.escholarshipsolutions.com</u> Make a calendar for your college application related activities Create a list of potential colleges / pathways List the colleges / universities that you are interested in on the "My Colleges" tab in eScholarship (recommended complete no later than November 1st). January - April	 Complete the FAFSA and apply to other scholarships http://www.FAFSA.gov http://battlecreekpublicschools.org/scholarships DUE BY MARCH 1: FAFSA application Bearcat Advantage Scholarship Application Battle Creek Community Foundation Scholarships applications Many other scholarship applications are also due by this date Review your post-secondary options Determine which career pathway you are interested in and which credential makes the most sense for you Formally accept the college / post-secondary pathway of your choice DUE BY APRIL 18th: Bearcat Advantage Scholarship Acceptance Form

June - August	 Attend orientation, register for classes Think carefully about maintaining balance for your fall schedule Check Add/Drop deadlines Reach out to the Bearcat Advantage Program Coordinator with any questions about utilizing your Bearcat Advantage scholarship Prepare to begin your post-secondary experience!
