Our Inquiries!

We have been busy bees in Kindergarten! Through our inquiry based learning, we have been talking about squirrels, where they live and how they prepare for winter. Did you know a squirrel can swim??

A lot of structure building has been taking place on our classroom carpets with blocks and straws. Students have been building tall skinny towers that kept toppling over. This lead us to discuss how we could change the structure to make it more **stable**.

Books, books, books! We have many young authors in our classroom. Children have been making books, first drawing illustrations and then adding the words! Way to go!!

French Vocabulary

The students have been practising our routine sentences: Bonjour, Comment ça va?, Viens ici, debout, assis. Students are also being encouraged to use both shape and colour words in a sentence: rectangle, cercle, triangle at carré, rouge, brun, orange, bleu, et vert.

Ex: J'ai un triangle bleu.
