RTA STICKERS (Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) Universal Pass

- If your [RTA sticker](#) was not placed on your ID card, then you may pick up your RTA sticker from [Access Services](#) in [Tinkham Veale University Center](#) from 9am-4pm Monday - Friday.

CBM (formerly BS/MS) Students: You do not need a new ID card. You will keep your undergraduate ID card. You will get an undergrad RTA pass.

IGS Students (grandfathered in under the old program): You should get a new graduate student ID card. You will need to turn in your undergraduate ID card at Access Services in order to receive your graduate ID card. Your undergraduate ID card should remain fully functional until you swap it out for a graduate ID card. You should get a grad RTA pass.

Dual Degree Students: You will have one graduate student ID card which will have all access needed for both programs.

CWRU Undergrad Alum: You should get a new graduate student ID card. You will need to turn in your previous ID card at Access Services in order to receive your graduate ID card.

Employee Students: You do not need a new ID card. You will keep your employee ID card. Any student access will be added to your current ID. You are not eligible for the RTA pass.
