

2026 Judge Willie J. Lovett, Jr. Scholarship Application – No Designation

Lovett Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

- The applicant must be in his/her Senior year at a high school in the State of Alabama or Georgia and attending a high school in the State of Alabama or Georgia for twelve (12) continuous months prior to May of 2026.
- The applicant must enroll full-time, in a four-year private or public accredited college or university in the fall semester of 2026*. Full-time enrollment consists of at least twelve (12) credits per semester or fifteen (15) credits per quarter and the completion of at least thirty (30) semester or forty-five (45) quarter credits annually.

*If the applicant plans to take a gap year for the fall of 2026, please explain in the application this intent, including details of the gap year. *See attached materials, #5 of application.*

- The applicant must have a 3.30 cumulative GPA or higher.
- The applicant must submit one letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor, teacher, employer, or mentor. *See application for details.*
- The applicant must submit **two (2)** essays with a **maximum of two hundred and fifty (250) words for each**. *See application for details.*
- The Judge Willie J. Lovett, Jr. Scholarship amount is \$3,000 per academic year for up to four years of undergraduate course work at a four-year private or public accredited college or university.
- The award is renewable each academic year for the Judge Willie J. Lovett, Jr. Scholarship recipients that (1) maintain a satisfactory cumulative GPA as determined by the Lovett Scholarship Team; (2) maintain full-time enrollment; and **(3) complete a minimum of twenty (20) hours of volunteer work**.

3. One recommendation letter is needed from a teacher, guidance counselor, employer or mentor with whom the applicant has had immediate contact. The recommendation should address the applicant's level of commitment to higher education, as well as attributes such as creativity, initiative, motivation, character, community service, and academic achievement.
*Recommendations may not come from immediate family members.
4. A photograph of yourself should be included in the application. You should be the only one in the photograph as the photograph will be used for the announcement and other Lovett Scholarship Program media.
5. If there is anything else you would like to share that may help the Lovett Scholarship Team evaluate your application (i.e. personal characteristics, obstacles you have overcome, or gap year plans), please explain that in writing.
