Course description:

Physics is suitable for students who wish to improve their general understanding of science within the context of real-life situations, and vital to those who need to continue studies in the sciences as part of their career aspirations. Year 13 physics further explores the study of mechanical systems, wave systems and applications of physics principles, as well as the processes of investigation and research. It involves a different way of thinking about and describing our surroundings and is useful to develop alternative thought patterns.

Course Objectives:

This course is aimed at developing critical scientific thinking skills and leads directly to university courses in science and engineering. It is also a prerequisite for some medical sciences and most engineering courses at tertiary level.
