KS4 Curriculum

Introduction

The overarching aim for English at KS4 is to promote high standards of language and literacy by equipping pupils with a strong command of the spoken and written word, and to develop their love of literature through widespread reading of challenging and diverse literature. Pupils will also develop their analytical skills, particularly those required for unseen fiction and non-fiction, as well as their creative writing skills for different audiences and in differing forms.

Pupils will begin the GCSE syllabus in Year 10. In Year 9, we provide GCSE-style texts and assessments so as to prepare pupils for the subsequent two years.
