Q: What do I need to do to join?

A: Fill out the application form which can be found on our [Linktree](#) and [Instagram](#). The deadline is Tuesday, October 7th at 11:59 pm. If this deadline has passed but you are still interested, please send an email to the Editors-in-Chief.

Q: How much time do I need to commit to The Reckoner?

A: Content boards (News, Editorial, Life, Photography, Illustrations) require you to submit a minimum of one piece per board-determined time period (check the Board Descriptions page for details).

Print board members are expected to contribute to print editions, which are published quarterly.

Q: How skilled do I need to be (in writing, photography, graphic design, etc.) to join the Reckoner?

A: We encourage everyone who is passionate about joining the Reckoner to apply. Training will be provided for each board.

Content boards require a basic level of writing expected from high school students, including proper grammar and spelling. The Editorial and Life boards are more likely to accept applicants with more skill in persuasive or creative writing. The Life, Illustrations, and Photography boards require some experience in art or photography for visual artists. Though encouraged, no experience is required to join the Print or Outreach boards.

Q: Can I apply to/be a member of multiple boards?

A: You are free to apply to as many boards as you want—however, we typically only accept members to a maximum of three different boards.

Q: If I was on The Reckoner last year, do I need to apply again?

A: Yes, all returning members must reapply to any boards they wish to join.

Q: When do leadership positions become available?

A: Members can apply to become apprentices for their respective boards around March. Managers for the next year are chosen from the group of apprentices - managers do not automatically retain their positions. This decision happens after the next Editor-in-Chief is elected in May.

Q: How many people are accepted to each board?

A: Each board has a different number of members, and the number of members varies from year to year. Typically the Editorial and Life boards accept around 20 people, the News Board accepts 10-20, and the rest of the boards accept around 10 people.

Q: Can I apply later in the year?

A: Yes. We will have another round of applications at the start of the second semester. However, there will be fewer positions available at that time.
