- **Attendance Procedures**

Families can report an absence by either calling the BC attendance line at 262-785-3994 or by emailing BCHSattendance@elmbrookschools.org. When reporting an absence, please include the student's name and the reason for the absence. All parents/guardians will receive a monthly attendance summary for each of their students. We also encourage students and parents to regularly monitor attendance records by logging into Infinite Campus.

- **Chromebook**

When teachers require technology for instruction and assessments during class, students must use their SDE-issued Chromebooks. Student-owned devices must be closed and put away during classtime. If you're having trouble with your Chromebook or need to update it, please visit this [site for guidance](#). If the issue continues, bring your Chromebook to the BC Library for assistance.

- **Early Assessment Request Form**

If a student foresees an upcoming absence and needs to take an assessment at an alternate time, please complete the [Early Assessment Request Form](#). Forms must be submitted to an associate principal at least one week prior to the requested assessment date, along with any supporting documentation. Please note that final approval is subject to school policy and instructor availability, and students will need to coordinate exact testing details directly with their teachers.

- **Student IDs**

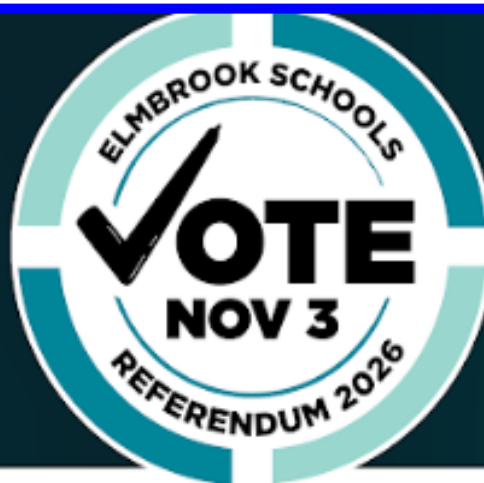
