Photo Essay

This task requires you to identify theme, character, setting and symbols through photographs and provide a brief explanation for each with supporting evidence from the text.

Thematic Essay

Write a two to three page essay about how the theme develops throughout the novel.

Quote Analysis

Select 8 - 10 quotes, accurately documented, and provide an analysis for each. Why are they important and how do they speak to themes?
