Please follow the guidelines listed below as you practice this summer:

- You will have <u>IXL</u> access throughout the summer and can log in through Clever. You <u>MUST</u> log
  in each time you complete skills if you do not, <u>your work will not be recorded as completed</u>.
- Practice every day (or almost every day).
- Do NOT work more than 20 minutes at a time 0R complete 20 problems per skill.
- If you are having trouble, <u>GET HELP</u> from an adult or older sibling.
- Some skills may be easy for you to do and will take less than 20 minutes just keep going and complete as many skills as possible in the 20 minutes. Some may be more difficult and may have to be worked on for more than one day.
- You will need to use paper and pencil for some of the skill sets.
- There is a place value chart to help pay attention to regrouping and grid paper to help line up your work located at the end of this packet to assist you.
- If you get a problem wrong, READ the EXPLANATION to help you understand the skill.
- Do NOT wait until the last minute to complete this work. Pace yourself set a schedule and stick
  to it. IXL provides you with a weekly pacing guide to help prevent "summer slide" and to help
  you manage your time.

**NOTE:** The recommendation for IXL is a maximum of 20 problems attempted on any one skill. Spend no more than 20 minutes a day. Just do your best!!
