Почетени са основните фигури в идеята за независимост, Мазини, Гарибалди и папата Пий 9-ти, който явно е централно англо-американско протеже на континента.

На 29 Март 1807 Heinrich Wilhelm Matthias Olbers (October 11, 1758 – March 2, 1840) открива третият по големина астероид Веста, сега втори след промотирането на Церера като планта джудже. Самия псевдоним Olbers, е съставен в чест на Sir John Frederick William Herschel, 1st Baronet KH FRS (7 March 1792 – 11 May 1871) през 1840. Olbers "умира" през 1840 година, когато Хершел изнася лекция пред членове на кралското научно дружество за създаването химичен метод на перманентни фотографии.
