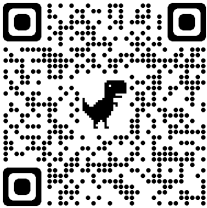

- The student and parent/guardian are responsible for returning all accessories for the instrument, rosin, shoulder rests and rock stops. This includes the replacement of broken strings on string instruments.
- The student and parent/guardian are responsible for loss or damage to the musical instrument while it is in the possession of the student.
- This fee will not be refunded if the student leaves the school district, fails a class, withdraws from the orchestra program, or is dismissed for disciplinary reasons.
- Insurance is not provided by the school district for any instrument. Families are encouraged to insure the instruments through household insurance riders or separate policies.
