# **COVID-19 Testing Policy**

Tests can also be purchased at the Duane Reade (425 Main St, New York, NY 10044) on Roosevelt Island.

If you recently recovered from COVID-19, you generally should not get retested for COVID-19 for three months after your symptoms began, if you had no symptoms, from the date you were tested, unless you develop new symptoms.

## **Travel**

Getting to and around Roosevelt Island is pretty straightforward, and you have lots of options to choose from

The **Subway** is the easiest, fastest, and cheapest way to get to Roosevelt Island.

- Take the **F train** to the "**Roosevelt Island**" stop.
- o Current one-way fare is \$2.75. An Unlimited Ride MetroCard is \$121.00 for 30 Days and \$32.00 for 7 Days. Single ride tickets are \$3.00.
- o If you need to get around NYC, we highly recommend you use the <u>MYmta</u> or <u>CityMapper</u>.

The **Tram**<sup>1</sup> is a fun way to travel to Roosevelt Island from Manhattan.



- Take the Tramway Car at 59th Street & Second Avenue Station (travel time is 4-5 minutes). Exit at the Tramway Station on Roosevelt Island.
- o Current one-way fare is \$2.75. An Unlimited Ride MetroCard is \$121.00 for 30 Days and \$32.00 for 7 Days. Single ride tickets are \$3.00.
- o <u>Tram Schedule</u>

<u>The Astoria route of the NYC Ferry</u> offers a great new transportation option for commuters.



- Current one-way fare is \$2.75. A 30-Day pass is \$121.00.
- $\circ$  The route connects Roosevelt Island to Astoria, Long Island City, Midtown East, and Wall Street.

The Red Bus operates in and around Roosevelt Island and is FREE to ride




