<p>June 17, 2024 6:00-8:00pm (Students &amp; Parents)</p>	<p><u><i>Graduation Guidelines and Information:</i></u></p> <p><b>For Graduates:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Graduates report to the Green Room at 5:00 for graduation preparation</li> <li>● Don't forget your cords and stoles!</li> <li>● Caps can be decorated and must follow the guidelines posted. <a href="#">2024 Cap Decorating Guidelines</a></li> <li>● Speakers, bring your speeches</li> </ul> <p><b>For Parents:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Graduation will be on Monday, June 17, 2024, from 6pm-8pm at the Pasadena Civic Auditorium - 300 E Green St, Pasadena, CA 91101</b></li> <li>● <b>Doors open at 5:00pm</b></li> <li>● Each graduate will receive <b>6 tickets for graduation on Tues 6/11/24</b></li> <li>● <i>There is no assigned seating, but we please ask guests to not leave empty seats to allow everyone to see their graduate.</i></li> <li>● <b>There will not be tickets available at the door</b></li> <li>● There is paid parking around the Civic Auditorium</li> <li>● <b>Florists</b> will be available outside before the graduation to buy flowers, or leis for your graduate.</li> <li>● <b>Big Heads, Noise Makers, Balloons, and any items that might disrupt the ceremony for other guests are not allowed.</b></li> <li>● Children under 5 who can sit within an adult's lap and not block the person behind will not need a ticket</li> <li>● You can bring celebration small posters or cutouts to cheer your child as they walk the stage. These items must not block the view of other audience members.</li> <li>● Please remain seated until all graduates have exited the ceremony.</li> <li>● Meet your graduates on the sidewalk outside of the Civic Auditorium</li> <li>● <b>Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in rejection from the ceremony.</b></li> </ul> <p><i>If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to email Mr. Martinez at <a href="mailto:sxm@lausd.net">sxm@lausd.net</a></i></p> <p><i>**The following information is being sent to all Class of 2024 families. <p>June 12th - June 13th (Students)</p>	<p><u>Grad Nite Info / Directions for those who purchased tickets:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Arrive at Bravo at 8am on June 12th - report to gym</li> <li>● <b><u>Disney policy requires that you must ride the bus to and from Bravo. You are not allowed to arrive to Disneyland on your own or leave on your own from Disneyland, unless there is an emergency. If you leave Disneyland without notifying your chaperone of the emergency, you will not be given your diploma or transcripts.</u></b></li> <li>● Bags will be checked prior to boarding busses</li> <li>● All participants are to remain sober for the entire trip.</li> <li>● Drugs, tobacco, drug &amp; tobacco paraphernalia, alcohol are prohibited at all times</li> <li>● There will be additional screenings with drug sniffing dogs at the Grad Nite entrance</li> <li>● If any banned substance is found, you will be turned over to Anaheim Police for further action.</li> <li>● All food and drinks must be unopened and store bought (factory sealed)</li> <li>● No glass bottles allowed</li> <li>● Attire must be Disney appropriate (no images of drugs, violence, weapons, gang affiliation)</li> <li>● Backpacks larger than 24" long x 15" wide x 18" high are not allowed in any theme park.</li> <li>● Bring your CA / School ID</li> <li>● You must follow ALL these requirements: <a href="https://disneyland.disney.go.com/park-rules/">https://disneyland.disney.go.com/park-rules/</a></li> <li>● Grad Nite ends at 2am BUT we will not return to Bravo until all bus riders have been accounted for. This takes an hour with all the graduates locating busses at 2am</li> <li>● Return to Bravo at 3:30am.</li> <li>● Grads and/or their chaperones may only bring in medication (including but not limited to inhalers and over the counter and prescription medications) in conformance with school policy and the requirements under applicable laws and regulations, such as Section 49423.1 of the California Education Code. (Change from prior years)</li> </ul>
<p>June 18, 20, 21 8:30-11:30am (Students)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Diploma and Transcripts pick up at Bravo in the main lobby</li> <li>● Return Graduation Gowns that were not purchased.</li> <li>● If seniors still owe any textbooks, library books, fees, etc, these must be returned before / when picking up diploma &amp; transcripts</li> <li>● DO NOT OPEN the transcripts. They are official because they are sealed. You might need these for additional programs or to mail to your colleges.</li> </ul>
