Summary of Accomplishments

DLG continues to contribute to the DPLA successfully. At the end of 2021, a total of 820,636 items were available through DPLA, an increase of approximately 5% over 2020. DLG currently is the ninth-largest contributor of records to DPLA. Sheila McAlister serves as the Georgia representative to the network council. Nicole Lawrence serves as chair of DPLA's Metadata Working Group.

Maintaining the sustainability of DLG's technical infrastructure continues to be a primary focus. In Spring 2021, in response to the sunsetting of Python 2, Georgia Historic Newspapers was migrated to the cloud. GALILEO development staff updated DLGAdmin to run a more current version of Rails. In fall 2021, the new Mirador 3 viewer debuted. DLG staff began to ingest partner IIIF manifests and share them with DPLA.

In August, we decommissioned the Civil War in the American South site as ASERL no longer supports it. Only the following standalone sites still exist:

GALILEO Development staff began creating a new Blacklight PUI for the Civil Rights Digital Library. In addition, they added controlled name functionality to DLGAdmin and have launched a [staging version of the site](#). We hope to complete the upgrade by the end of 2022.

In 2021, the first three Spotlight exhibits debuted: Georgia newspaper history, convict labor, and race relations in Forsyth County. An additional five exhibits are in the pipeline for publication.

- Urban renewal.
- Arts and the LGBTQ community.

We hosted three interns. In 2022, we will assess the program with an eye towards developing a more sustainable workload.

This year, DLG supported three scholarly journals on the OJS platform: *The Journal of Higher Education Outreach and Engagement*, *The Mathematics Educator*, and *Borrowers and Lenders: The Journal of Shakespeare and Appropriation*. In addition, DLG assisted BL's move to its new organizational home and OJS host. DLG staff will decommission the DLG-hosted site in 2022.

In 2021, UGA completed its IR move to an Esploro-hosted version. The move centralized assets and permitted the decommissioning of two UGA-maintained legacy sites. An improved front end debuted with enhanced documentation. Handle.net persistent links were also updated. Colleen Gardina will serve as a contact point for faculty wishing to deposit in IR.

In 2021, two more institutions, Valdosta State and August University, began using DLG to host their archival management systems. The following public instances are live:

Both Clayton State and Augusta University are still cleaning their data, so their public interfaces have not yet launched. Nevertheless, assuming an average yearly fee of \$4000 for Lyrasis hosting, DLG's ASpace hosting services saved each of these partners at least \$2500 (total ROI: \$17,500).

The Imaging and Curation unit maintained its productivity in image conversion and its work with vendor- and partner-created files despite working in a hybrid fashion for half of the year. They captured 35,591 archival images. In addition, the unit trained on and implemented a new RAW capture image workflow for transmissive materials. The new equipment and workflows will improve throughput and improve image quality. Upon return to the office full-time, the unit resumed AIP creation and upload to our preservation systems. In 2020, unit staff loaded 1.4 GB to dlarchive; and 42 loads to ARCHive. In 2021, by contrast, unit staff loaded over 7 TBs of files to DLG's various archival storage platforms. In 2022, staff will begin loading into AWS Glacier as well.

In 2021, DLG staff harvested 172 new collections from 27 new partners (approximately 99,165 items). The unit also completely reprocessed 116,509 records from two of the largest contributors to the DLG dataset, Atlanta University Center and Georgia State University. Both institutions implemented significant changes in the DAMS that required a complete re-ingest of their materials.

In addition, the metadata unit made it a priority to investigate and implement inclusive metadata recommendations. The new workflow includes research and usage of alternate authorities and controlled vocabularies where appropriate. These changes are reflected in the DLG metadata guidelines, where broad recommendations are made for the description and subject fields and a list of resources to guide users towards appropriate description methods determined by content.

Lastly, the metadata unit developed a method for creating and harvesting thumbnails which have been incorporated into regular processing. Thumbnail coverage is up to 93% of records, and the unit is making progress on the remaining items.

The Georgia Newspaper Project was understaffed in 2021 and underwent other personnel changes. The GNP manager took a voluntary demotion. We hope to hire a new manager in 2022. In 2021, GNP staff focused on completing the born-digital capture pilot. The pilot was successful: 32,152 pages from 1464 issues of 13 titles were released over the year. Workflow has been refined for further efficiency. Staff hopes the arrival of the new production storage will further increase throughput. GNP will roll out this program to additional publishers in 2022.

In 2021, DLG released 353,584 pages of newly digitized newspaper content, an 11% decrease from 2020. Processing slowed because of the large number of new titles added (more than 140 over 2020). To increase the number of pages released, staff load issues without title essays. In 2022, DLG hopes to hire graduate students to write and revise newspaper history essays. Also, the Watson-Brown Foundation and the National Digital Newspaper program provided additional newspaper digitization funding.

The [subgranting program](#) continues to be a success. In 2020, we completed the work of ten of the 2020/2021 projects and one of the 2021/2022 projects and selected an additional nine projects, two of which are with new partners.

DLG staff worked to provide enhanced educational offerings to K-16 teachers and students. Working with New Georgia Encyclopedia and National History Day staff, DLG staff contributed to the [National History Day Georgia 2022 Theme explorer site](#). In addition, DLG began an eighth-grade poster series focused on GHN 's newspaper holdings.

DLG staff continued to publish a quarterly newsletter and support a partner listserv. Staff continued to make freely available aggregate usage statistics for DLG sites and DPLA and shared institution-specific statistics to partners who requested them. We hosted a track of three well-received sessions at the GALILEO Annual Conference. Topics were based on feedback from partners. In 2021 DLG co-sponsored a series of seven webinars with Georgia Public Library Services and held two townhalls, one in January (DEIA) and one in July (IIIF). The schedule was as follows:

The seven webinars boasted an attendance of 260 out of 516 registrants for a return-of-investment of \$13,000. According to post-webinar surveys, responding attendees reported that 96.4% would recommend or highly recommend attendance to others, 93.1% agreed or strongly agreed that they would apply the knowledge gained, 93.1% agreed or strongly agreed that they learned during webinars, and 96.5% were engaged during the webinars. Given COVID, DLG staff did only two site/outreach visits.

DLG held its first [partner event](#) on the afternoons of April 4-6. The online event included a keynote speech, planned presentations, partner spotlights, lightning talks, and discussion groups. Greta Bahneman, Minnesota Digital Library (MDL), and Jason Roy, Director of the University of Minnesota's Digital Library Services, spoke on the MDL's gap analyses. The planned presentation topics were in three tracks: Digital Preservation, DEI, and ArchivesSpace migrations. Four partners did spotlight presentations, and another seven presented lightning talks. Topics included

113 registered for at least one day of the event, and 78 attended at least one day of sessions. 32 USG, 15 PL, 13 GPALS, 5 governmental, 4 corporate, 4 museum, 1 technical college, and one non-Georgia academic library person attended. Discussion sessions were not well attended, but those who attended were highly engaged. The 2022 conference will comprise two afternoons and not include discussion sessions.

DLG continued to host a track of sessions at the GALILEO annual conference. The sessions included "Filling in the Gaps: Delivering Oral History Online," "DLG Technology Update," "ArchivesSpace," "Digital Projects Showcase," and "Local History in Context: Developing a Public Library Digital Exhibit Curators' Cohort."

DLG staff piloted affinity group follow-up discussions after two webinars (SEO and digital preservation). While sparsely attended, participants were highly engaged during the discussions.
