Big Frog T-Shirts and More in Clairemont produces Marston's P.E. uniforms for sale. If your child's current P.E. uniform fits fine, there is no need to purchase a new one. Families are encouraged to visit the store in person at 4951 Clairemont Drive to ensure sizing is correct. 2026-2027 NEIGHBORHOOD BUS – ALL NEW AND RETURNING RIDERS MUST SUBMIT FORM

Marston plans to again offer a FREE neighborhood bus with at least 3 stops. Marston and SDUSD determine the stop locations based on where prospective riders reside. To express interest in the free neighborhood bus for 2026-2027, [complete this form](#) as soon as possible. If capacity is an issue, priority will be given to families who use the bus daily, both morning and afternoon. Riders who do not use the bus regularly, may lose their bus pass to create room to riders who need the bus daily.

AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAMS

Marston will again offer a robust number of free/low-cost after-school programs. Participation in these programs helps wellness, social-connectedness and the dismissal pick-up process. This year Marston and Toby Wells YMCA will be providing a JV sports league for boys basketball and girls volleyball. All those games will be at Marston on Thursday afternoons. These leagues will include teams from PB, Muirlands, Pershing, Innovation and DePortola. SUGGESTED SUPPLIES FOR 2026-2027

1. Wired headphones with the standard 3.5 mm aux jack. These can be easily stored in the backpack and brought to class daily. Please note that wireless earbuds are not permitted on campus because they are not visible to teachers. Over the head headphones are permitted, but they can be bulky and may not fit in the backpack.
2. Traditional supplies: pens, pencils and paper. Some teachers will have additional recommendations, but please wait until those are announced by the teacher during the first week of school. Families that need assistance with basic supplies should ask their counselor or teachers.
3. Chromebook protective case. Unfortunately some students slam their computers shut, drop their computer, throw backpack on the ground, etc. Per district policy, families are financially responsible for damage to Chromebooks. [Click here](#) for Chromebook care information and fee amounts.
