Abstract

Write a structured abstract, single space, times new roman 12. 1-in. margins on all sides. The abstract consists of five headings: Background, Objective, Methods, Results, and Conclusion.

Abstract should not be more than 250 words and add keywords (3-10 words). Wording should be concise and present only the essential elements. The structure of abstract including 5 headings: Background, Objective, Methods, Results, and Conclusion.

Keywords:

Keywords need to be descriptive and capture the most important aspects of your paper. Include three to five words, phrases, or acronyms as keywords.



INTRODUCTION

1. Formatting the text

The text of your paper should be formatted as follows:

- 12 point Times or Times New Roman.
- The text should be set to single line spacing.
- Paragraphs should be justified.
- The first paragraph after a section or subsection heading should not be indented; subsequent paragraphs should be indented by 5 mm.

2. Sections, subsections and subsubsections

The use of sections to divide the text of the paper is optional and left as a decision for the author. Where the author wishes to divide the paper into sections the formatting shown in table 2 should be used.

2.1. Style and spacing

Instrument

- Please state the information whether the present study develop, adopt, adapt or modify the instrument. Moreover, explain state the validity and reliability of the instrument. Furthermore, explain how to use each instrument to measure your variables.

Intervention (this heading is only for experimental studies)

- Explain briefly the process of intervention, setting, and those who did intervention.
- If you have control group, please explain what kind of intervention you do to them.

Data Collection

- Describe when and where the data were collected.
- Describe who collect the data.
- Provide information if any research assistants/enumerators/local coordinators were involved.

Data Analysis

CONCLUSION

- Provide real conclusions from the main findings without repetition.
