### Introductions & Updates

- Name, institution, position updates, gov info updates, what have you done with gov docs lately?
  - Next meeting: February. Maybe DU?
  - Answering: Name, place, positions, What have we done with Gov Docs.
  - CU: Kate no longer head of Gov Info Library but “Lead of RAD Research Services”. Kate is still the Regional Depository Coordinator. Phil is the point person for the collection. Election outreach was the latest gov docs related thing. Open Positions: library services specialist staff positions, E-resources librarian, Data librarian, and head of Rare and Distinctive Collections. The after school special. Withdrawing other state documents.
  - State Pubs: Hiring tech services librarian. Presentation at Cal for national history day. Miranda, working on getting items digitized. Double budget since last time. Online early next year.
  - Supreme Court: First time representing in a while. Discussed structure. Legal specific. Walk-ins are welcome and hours are mandated. 8-5. Most documents are in the basement but can be requested on-site
  - DU: A lot of positions, not public yet. Access Services, 1 year reference position, associate Dean, systems library, design and discovery librarian, perhaps business librarian. Since 2007 Gov Docs are offsite. Writing books.
  - CU Law: Looking for a new director, digitization coordinator, acquisitions. Working on Folio transition, looking for being a print selector for CFR and preservation steward.
  - Auraria: Hired an HR person, Web Services developer, online learning librarian. 5 open positions, 2 collections development, e-resources, system librarian, assistant director of operations. Went through a reorg. Not much in gov docs, most not in print. Would like to look at how to withdraw maps in future maps. Still gets print maps.
  - DPL: Denver passed mill levy for DPL. Going to be hiring. Withdrawing docs quickly and cataloging items kept. Still limited hours. Construction into 2024.
  - UNC Greeley: Jen has a new title. New liaison organization, down 6 faculty positions, all tenure track doing reference and instruction, all collection development is centralized. Hiring Dean, interviewing for teaching and outreach librarian. Have concentrated on CO collection.

- UCCS: Reorg to be official in Jan. Hiring Outreach librarian, digital scholarship librarian. Looking at selection list and revamped what was wanted. Hoping for a more current collection.
- Mines: In a healthier spot. Working on digitizing a unique Saudi Collection.
