 1. MS PTO is different than elementary schools. We are a bigger group but not as many fundraising events. Main income is annual appeal, with suggested donation of \$125/student, but all donations are appreciated.
 2. We exceeded last year's goal with significant impact through corporate match programs – please ask your employers!
 3. Can now [donate online](#) and immediately get a confirmation for taxes.
 4. Our goal is to increase participation from last year's 33% overall participation.
 5. Where do dollars go? Speakers, authors, creative arts, language festivals, turkey promenade entertainment, reusable pinnies...

3. What does the PTO do? (Julie Bryan)

- a. Weekly newsletter to parents/caregivers – can send once membership toolkit has closed and families are confirmed; only teachers and staff can use ParentSquare so watch for emails; can also find info on [website](#).
- b. Fund events, speakers and teacher needs – teachers can apply for specific needs
- c. Coordinate volunteers for events, teacher support – please volunteer! There are many roles of all sizes.
- d. Connection between staff/teachers/administration and parents/caregivers – meet with Dr. Ito and Dr. Lussier regularly
- e. Raise parent concerns with WMS and WPS administration
 - i. Central Council
 - ii. Board meetings

Overall, we are really looking to build a community of parents and caregivers. It's not just about events – we are focused this year on bringing parents together in support of our children and school. Please join PTO meetings!

Discussions include what's going well, what's tricky, issues, how school is handling things, assemblies and content. Not a heavy lift – one hour per month. Reach out to Teri with questions.

including at end of Back-To-School night (please join!). Last year, we did a day after school on Friday with Chick-Fil-A where Boston kids could stay and invite Wellesley friends to join. Had a big roller skating event in Boston. Have a mailing list and can sign up.

i. Turkey Promenade (Janine Paye)

- 1. All school event in which kids bring food or household supplies for needy families; on Wed before Thanksgiving, all Advisories take food on a "promenade" to gym to leave food, then go to gym to celebrate
- 2. Very fun for students, each advisory has a theme (e.g. holiday theme, sports theme); significant annual donation source for Voices Against Violence and also supports Wellesley Food Pantry; from parent volunteer perspective, each grade has ~1 hour when bringing food around, can sign up for your kid's grade as a parent volunteer in the gym; need a lot of hands for physical work (sorting, checking dates, removing glass, etc.)
- 3. Janine Paye and Tanya Lisowski are co-chairing; reach out to help with planning. Big lift on collecting boxes, grab as many as possible!

ii. Mini Marathon – spring; all school event; ~one mile; not a fundraiser, just a fun event for kids; PE teachers run the event and PTO supports

iii. Teacher Appreciation Week – spring; have a few volunteers to co-chair; plus have smaller events of support and appreciation through the year; watch newsletter

iv. June Book Fair – in June PTO meeting; focus on summer reading books

v. Language events – one-hour festivals after school in ~Jan – March; Lunar New Year, French Fete, Deutschfest

7. Table Talk

- a. What topics do you want to talk about at PTO meetings? What ideas do you have for PTO events, activities or meetings?
- b. Themes:
 - i. Topical areas:
 1. Technology – how are we dealing with kids finding workarounds to banned programs, how do we evolve through the year?
 2. AI – how are teachers using it, are students being taught AI safety?
 3. WMS food – follow up on last year’s survey and next steps
 4. Advisories / houses / half-houses – how does all this work, methodology, formulas for sizing, etc? Lots of focus on the how and why of half-houses, and what the future strategy is for half-houses.
 5. Curriculum variances across classrooms, e.g. some classes don’t really use summer reading books while others build assignments around them. How is this measured and coordinated?
 6. Curriculum content with focus on literacy and math
 - ii. Structural ideas
 1. How to receive and respond to feedback from with parent community? How to create dialogue?
 2. Build community through information sharing. Potential for events around various communities’ cultural events and celebrations – “international game day.”
 3. Potential to have sub-communities, e.g. new families parent group
 4. Expand information sharing on volunteering, e.g. volunteer fair, kick-off meetings before sign-ups
 5. PTO meetings times – consider evenings, Zoom; enable more involvement
 6. Create a way for parents to anonymously submit questions to inform future PTO meetings, e.g. form on website, link in newsletter
 7. Create grade-specific parent socials
 8. Sixth-grade or new-family coffees – to help with the questions we don’t even know to ask
 9. Create an overview to help new parents understand paths for help and resources, e.g. if you need [x], you can go to dept heads; potential to connect to existing guidance through first newsletter?
