Jim Dyer Trophy	Outstanding Competitor in Regular Season Meets; shows competitive spirit, performs to best of his ability, shows dedication to track; traditionally given to a senior	Former runner and long-time official
Clayton Ellis Trophy	Champion of Open High Jump	South Portland athlete later killed in World War II
Lincoln H. Hascall Trophy	Champion of Int, 45 Hurdles	Competed and coached at South Portland High School; at one time served as meet director for SMAA
Frederick T. Jeffrey, Jr. Trophy	Champion of Open 1- Mile Run	Timer at Portland Expo beginning in the 1940s
Charles Kahill Trophy	Champion of Open 800m Run	Judge at Portland Expo meets
Henry L. "Hank" LaVallee Trophy	Champion of Open 200m Dash	Athlete at Thornton Academy and Later Baseball Coach at South Portland
Ralph A. Leavitt Trophy	Champion of Open Shot Put	Long-time Portland Coach
Robert McGlone Trophy	Champion of Sr. 40 Dash	Portland High School athlete of 1930s who was killed in World War II
Daniel J. Murphy Trophy	Champion of Open 400m Dash	Timer at Expo since 1950s

George Vinall Trophy	Top Performer in Open Division During Southwestern Meet	Athletic Director at Deering High School and also league meet director from 1920s through 1940s; Vinall Trophy given to top player/sportsman of Western Maine Class A Basketball Tournament also named for him
John J. "Jack" Wilkinson Trohpy	Champion of Open 2-Mile Run	Former coach at Bonny Eagle, Cheverus, and Portland
Girls Indoor Track Angie Abraham Award	Awarded to Outstanding Senior Class Athlete	Description of Individual Honored Deering High School athlete who passed away at a young age
John Casavola Award	Most Valuable-Senior Division	Long-time dash record holder at Portland Expo
Harold Harmon Award	Most Valuable-Junior Division	Long-time timer at Portland Expo
Shirley Jones Award	Most Improved- Senior Division	Long-time South Portland track coach
Softball Peter Meagher Award	Awarded to Player/Sportswoman of the Year	Description of Individual Honored Former Athletic Director at Noble High School who served as SMAA softball liaison
