Welcome to Liberty's Chorus. We want your kids to feel like our classrooms are home, and in chorus I want all of you to be part of our family.

Many of you have already signed off on our <u>syllabus</u>. On the following pages I will summarize the more urgent matters - Formalwear and SchoolPay, Fundraising, Trips, etc. I will also include information about **All-State Chorus** auditions and **District Honor Chorus**.

Next week students will start practicing their music at home! In the past, practice logs have been for a grade. They are required to practice 30 minutes per week, divided up any way they want. It

could be 10 minutes for 3 days, 15 minutes for 2 days, 5 minutes for 6 days, etc. This is part of our STAR values: Accountability for doing our part lends itself to the Teamwork which is necessary for a great choral experience. They will log the time at the beginning of class, which is an excellent exercise in executive skills. They are working on "Peace Song," which will first be performed at our school's 9/11 ceremony and also at our fall concert on October 7.
